THE FESTIVAL OF THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Today, of course, is the great feast of Corpus Christi, the day singled out by Holy Mother Church for special contemplation of the mystery of the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist and for unique adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Let us, therefore, take time this day to do what the Church asks of us and spend it in humble adoration of so great a mystery. There's no better way to do that than by taking part in...

...THE ANNUAL FLORISSANT CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

What began 150 or so years ago had been revived and perpetuated in our time, namely, the great Eucharistic Procession on the feast dedicated to the mystery of the Real Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. It has become our heritage as citizens of the proud and historic city of Florissant. It starts at 1:30PM in Sacred Heart church this Sunday. Special invitation is given to our first communicants to have pride of place in the procession, wearing their First Communion apparel. There will be refreshments waiting for us at the end. Try to arrive by 1:15.

SCHOOL'S OUT FOR SUMMER

With the graduation of our eighth graders last Thursday, school is now officially over for 2015-16, our 50th year. There will be no more school Masses until August at 8:00AM nor Benediction at 2:45PM on Tuesdays. Pray for the safety of our little ones!

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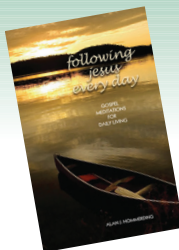
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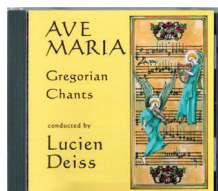
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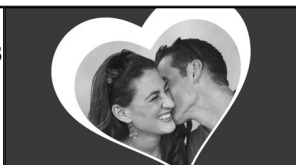
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
