We had a really great turnout, the food was world-class, the band was (as advertised) rock-'em & sock-'em, and a wonderful time was had by all. All thanks to Jeanette Smith, Don Krause, and all who helped. We even made a few bucks (all the bills aren't in yet, but it looks like it's going to be in the \$9,000/10,000 range)! We'll be starting up again soon. Remember: for \$150 per person (\$200 per couple) you get a chance to win \$250 in each month's drawing and a spot at the dinner/dance next spring (where you'll be eligible for the *big* prize (\$2,000!)).

Consistent with our parish custom, we will have only one Mass this Monday, May 29, at 9:00AM.

UPCOMING EVENTS

Even though our school closed, our parish is still vibrant, strong, and, most of all, *active*! We plan to keep offering many activities that are social, spiritual, intellectual, cultural and recreational in the years ahead, and we hope you will take part in them. Here's the things we have already on the docket for this summer:

- Monday, June 5! It's the Feast of St. Boniface (patron saint of the Germans), and so to honor him, re-acquaint North County with the best of German fare, and have a great time while doing it, we're going to have our first (annual?) St. Boniface Day German Food Fest here at St. Angela's. Our nationally-known food-meister, Don Krause, is whipping up a tantalizing table of Teutonic treats, from the apfelstrudel to the schnitzel, with his typical skill and flair. We might make a dollar or two, and if we do, it will go to St. Vincent de Paul, but it's mostly just to have some fun, so count on having dinner *mit uns* (with us!) on June 5!

- Sunday, June 18: the annual Florissant, Sacred Heart-to-St. Ferdinand Shrine Corpus Christi Procession, in the afternoon after the last Mass. Refreshments to follow.

- Sunday, July 16: in concert - former parishioner and musician, Danny Kuehler, who returns to our parish for another benefit recital. You remember his last one: it was *magnificent*! Danny has recently been accepted into the *ultra*-prestigious Eastman School of Music, and will share the benefits of his talent and training with us in what promises to be a wonderful afternoon of the best piano music.

CHAPEL VEILS

In 1 Corinthians 11: 1-16, St. Paul writes at great length, making the point that women should cover their heads in church. And so, from apostolic times until right after the Vatican Council, this practice was universally observed. And then it stopped. Nobody mandated that it stop, repeat, *nobody*. It just stopped. The Blessed Apostle declared that "Woman is the glory of man..." and, "if a woman has long hair, it is her glory", and so he thought it fitting for a woman to cover her head in church. (Anybody who grew up in the 70's when big-haired Farrah Fawcett dominated the entertainment scene would know exactly what St. Paul was talking about!) Most of all, when a woman covers her head in church it is an expression of humility, and does anybody really want to make a case that we have too much of that in the Church today? And so in the apostolic spirit of St. Paul, our parish is offering chapel veils to any woman who would like one. They were supplied by an anonymous donor and will be available in the back of church this weekend.
