After much consultation, the smartest move was to repair the old unit, so that is what we're going to do. There's every expectation that it will give us the same service for a comparable number of years. Right now, it looks like we should be back in our freshly-cooled church building after the next two Sundays, meaning that we will most likely have Mass in the lunchroom on the weekends of June 24/25 and July 1/2 (we will postpone the doughnut until July 8/9). Obviously, if the church is ready sooner, we'll be back in it before then. In any case, I have dispersed envelopes designated for a special collection to help pay for the new unit. SAFE ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM COMPLIANCE:

Anyone who works with or volunteers with children must be compliant with the Safe Environment Program of the Archdiocese of Saint Louis set forth by the USCCB. (United States Conference of Catholic Bishops)

Compliance includes attending a Protecting God's Children Workshop, completing a Worker Registration Form to obtain a background check, and reading and signing a Code of Ethical Conduct. Each location must have copies of individual background checks & code of ethics forms on file for all active volunteers and employees. Additional background checks may be necessary if you have lived out of state in previous years.

To register online for a Protecting God's Children Workshop, please visit www.archstl.org and click on the Protecting God's Children link. You will be redirected to the VIRTUSOnline.org site to complete the registration process. The Code of Ethical Conduct and worker registration forms are available from your parish Child Safety Coordinator and may also be located on your parish website. If you have questions or need assistance with this process please contact the parish office or the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Program at 314-792-7272.

Missouri Background Checks are obtained when you begin your ministry and are updated every even numbered year. Please let the parish office know if you would like to be removed from the list of active volunteers. You must also contact the Missouri Family Care Safety Registry at 1-866-422-6872 with address changes.

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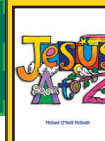
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
