Don't forget that tomorrow (Monday, June 5), being the feast of St. Boniface (who is for the Germans what St. Patrick was for the Irish), we are going to celebrate in grand style with our first-ever "St. Boniface Day German Food Festival". 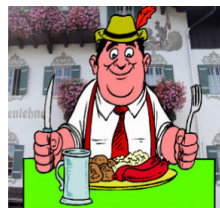
CENTENNIAL OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA

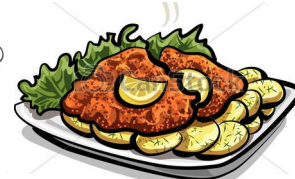
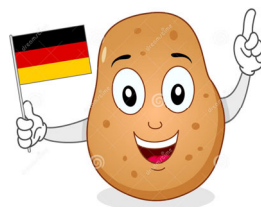
FEAST of ST. BONIFACE (patron saint of the Germans)

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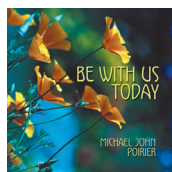
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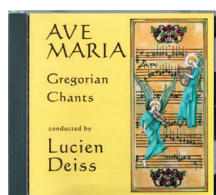
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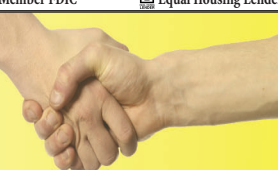
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
