From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT AUGUST IS THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT!

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

This Tuesday, August 15, is the Feast of the Assumption of Our Lady. It is, of course, a holy day of obligation. To better enable you to fulfill your obligation and attend Holy Mass, we will celebrate three: one tomorrow (Monday, August 14) at 5:00PM and two on Tuesday: the usual 8:00AM Mass (followed by P.H. Devotions and Exposition) and one at 7:00PM. Adoration will take place as usual on Tuesday (in church!), but the 7:00PM Mass will conclude it.

A SCURRILOUS AND DETESTABLE LIE!

The infamous 18th c. Irish politician, Sir Boyle Roche, once thundered in righteous indignation: “Half the lies our enemies tell of us are untrue!” In his spirit, I call out our neighbors to the west for a contemptible lie that is clearly untrue. I was driving down the Rue St. Denis in Old Town Florissant the other day and I couldn’t believe the blatant falsehood that was revealed to my eyes. There, on the Sacred Heart Parish message board, it said that their (i.e., Sacred Heart’s) parish gardens were the best in Florissant. Well, this was more than flesh can bear! Everybody knows, and it’s demonstrably a fact, that St. Angela’s are the best in the whole archdiocese! What’s to be done? As Mark Twain once wrote: “They had better swallow this lie to spare their abandoned reptile carcasses the cowhiding they so richly deserve!” Should we follow through on Twain’s directive? Quoting Sir Boyle again, I say: “I answer in the affirmative with an emphatic, ‘NO!’” Cutting them some slack, however, I must point out that despite our Florissant zip code, we are technically not actually in Florissant, but rather in Shovel-town. Nevertheless, the truth will come out, and the community needs to know it!

All that now is nugatory: some dude removed both light poles with his vehicle and now there’s nothing there. I hope the county replaces them soon...

Commemorate the Centennial of Our Lady of Fatima at St. Angela Merici Parish

Our Lady made a series of appearances to the children at Fatima, Portugal on the 13th of the month from May to October, 1917. Her message was that if all prayed (especially the rosary), there would be peace. Tragically instead, over 300 million people died in the 20th century in wars and revolutions across the world. We still urgently need peace in our homes, families, region, country and the world. To commemorate 100th anniversary of Fatima, Pope Frances has approved a plenary indulgence for the remission of ones' sins for the faithful who visit Fatima. He has also made this indulgence available to those who pray in the presence of a statue of Our Lady of Fatima on the 13th of the month from May to October this year. To receive the indulgence, one must also complete the usual conditions of praying for the intentions of the Pope, and receiving the Eucharist and going to Confession within 8 days before or after.

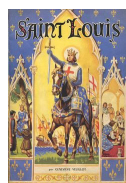

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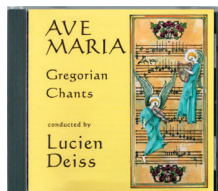
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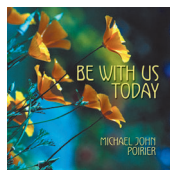
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
