From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT OCTOBER IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST HOLY ROSARY!

CONVOCATION

Even though this week will see the quadrennial convocation of the priests of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, our parish will still have the 8:00AM daily Mass (with all the devotions as well) all throughout the week. I will be gone on vacation (I typically take it in October) next weekend and Fr. Anthony Palazzolo, representing “Food for Life” will be taking my place. He will make an appeal for his organization (they have been here before); please be generous.

GERMANFEST!

We still do not have the numbers from the Germanfest, but the voice of the people has spoken as loudly and as eloquently as possible: **A GREAT TIME WAS HAD BY ALL!** Our copious thanks, again, to all who were involved (and I think that was *everybody*) and look for it again next year!

FLOOD RELIEF

Archbishop Carlson has asked all parishes of the archdiocese to take up a collection to help the victims of the recent floods in our country, and so I am asking all who wish to help to take a plain envelope, write “**FLOOD RELIEF**” on the outside of it, and drop it in the collection basket in the next couple of weeks.

MONTH OF THE ROSARY

Every year, the month of October is given over to the most holy rosary in our Catholic piety. That’s because today (Oct. 7) is the actual Feast of the Most Holy Rosary, even though it’s not celebrated because it is being pre-empted by the Sunday celebration. In the thousand or so years, that faithful Catholics have prayed the rosary, it has accomplished immeasurable good and brought about unsurpassed spiritual blessings. Whether you pray it alone or with others, in church or in your home, in the car on the way to work (yes, that can be done very safely!), and on some other conveyance on the ride home, pray the rosary. Pray it with your family. There is no limit to the benefits that accrue when you do!

SUNDAY SCHOOL AT THE 9:30 MASS

I’ve been writing about this for the past couple of weeks, and this program, run by our good parishioner, Laura Vietmeier, will be held in the old pre-school classroom and will start this weekend. It will be for 3 to 5-year-olds.

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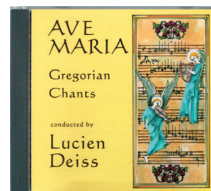
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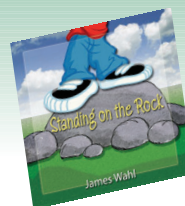
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
