THE YEAR OF GRACE, 2019

With this Sunday, the Feast of Christ the King, the Year of Grace 2018 comes to a close (although, technically, its terminal day is this coming Saturday), and next Sunday, Dec. 2, will see the beginning of the Year of Grace 2019, as the Church's cycle of feasts and seasons reboots; we then commence to celebrate the events that saved us all over again. So, a happy new year of grace, 2019, to you all!

ADVENT VESPERS

One of my most cherished memories of childhood is my taking part in the annual, *traditional* Advent Vespers, leading to the celebration of the Birth of the Messiah. In former days, it was observed in the form of a *novena*, i.e., nine consecutive evenings of prayer. We have begun the tradition of celebrating those solemn Vespers here at St. Angela, adapting them to the evenings of just the four Sundays of Advent. Those of you who have come to them know exactly how powerful and beautiful they are. They are, as I already mentioned, the Church's solemn *evening prayer*, the same as the monks, religious, and clergy pray each day, but these have special commemorations, reminding us of the long gap between the promise of a Savior and His actual arrival, the prophecies that foretold it, and the great hope born of the expectation that He would come soon.

This is something that the kids particularly love, so bring them and the grandkids. They start at 7:00PM each Sunday (starting next week on Dec. 2) and last about half an hour. Make sure you get both your candle and booklet as you come into church, and, by all means, let your neighbors and friends know that we'd love to have them join us, too!

OUR LADY OF GUADALUPE

One magnificent devotion that has grown exponentially in the 40 years I've been a priest is the veneration and homage paid to Our Lady under title of Our Lady of Guadalupe. It reminds us of her singular patronage of the "New World", she being now known as the "Empress of the Americas". Her feast day falls on Dec. 12 each year and, as we did last year, we will honor her with another evening of Mexican fare. It will be a true mid-Advent fiesta, with all the best of south-of-the-border cuisine, and even a piñata for the little ones. Plan on being there!

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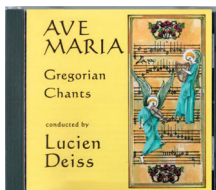
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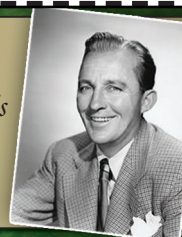


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
