REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!

LENT, 2018

We're well under way now in the annual 40-day retreat called Lent. This is just to remind you of the special events of the season (in addition to the usual devotions; Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, Confession, etc.). We have the Stations of the Cross every Friday evening at 7:00, followed by the Lenten Speaker Series (presented in conjunction with St. Joseph Catholic radio). There will be an 8:00AM Mass every Saturday during Lent as well. Please consider joining us for Morning Prayer, which many of us pray together before the 8:00AM Mass each day and at 9:00AM on Sundays. We can set you up with the books and training on how to take part in the Church's official morning praise of God.

WATCH FOR IT

Scheduled to be released in Holy Week is a new movie on the life of St. Paul, "Paul, the Apostle of Christ". It stars Jim Caviezel (who portrayed Our Lord in Mel Gibson's, "The Passion of the Christ") as St. Luke the Evangelist. I haven't seen it, but it looks like it might be pretty good, and has been endorsed by some Catholic sources whom I trust (and who apparently *have* seen it). The published release date is March 28, right before Holy Thursday.

POLISH/PHILLY FOOD NIGHT

As announced, our next ethno-hagiographical food celebration will be on Saturday evening, March 3, as we honor St. Katharine Drexel (of Philadelphia) and St. Casimir, the Polish Prince. So far, we've honored St. Boniface (German), St. Louis (French), St. Wenceslaus (Czech), Ss. F. X. Cabrini and R. P. Duchesne (American), O. L. of Guadalupe (Mexican), and St. Angela Merici (Italian), and they've all been great. This one presents a wide variety of foods, ranging from Piekutowski's famous Polish Sausage & kraut to authentic Philadelphia cheese steaks & pretzels. You don't want to miss this one! Serving starts after the 5:00PM Mass and lasts until 8:00.

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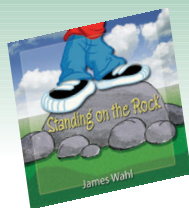


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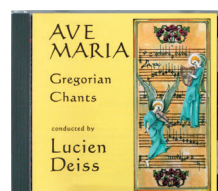
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
