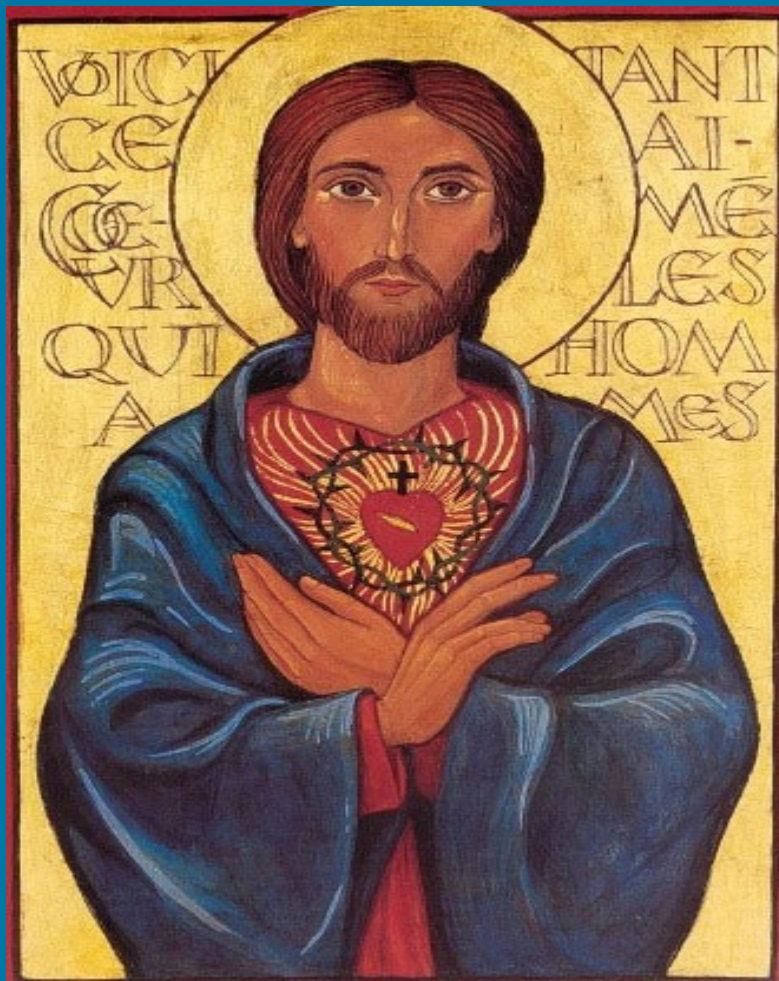

From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

PASTOR ON THE EAST COAST

As you read this, I will be in New Jersey enjoying the hospitality of my relatives (i.e., sponging again). Our sturdy and faithful Deacon Joe Kroutil will have Communion Services in my absence this week (see below for their location) and a missionary (see below) will cover this weekend's Masses. I'll be back next Saturday.

LA SALETTE MISSIONARIES COMING TO ST. ANGELA'S

Fr. Edwin Ariola of the La Salette Missionary Fathers will be the celebrant of our Masses this weekend. Please welcome him and be generous in response to his appeal!

A HOTBED OF ACTIVITY!!!!

That would be your parish, St. Angela Merici! There are many new, exciting, and wonderful things going on and I want you to be abreast of them. Here they are:

1. **NEW BELLS** - You've probably already heard them chiming out the hours. Our old bell system was over twenty years old and if you know electronics, anything that old is a dinosaur. A generous anonymous donor has given us the money to install a new, state-of-the-art system that is programmed for the entire year to chime the hours (accurate to the second), hymns, the *Angehus*, tolls for funerals, and peals for weddings. It's great, and as we learn more how to use it, it will get even better!

2. **NEW FLOOR** - The tile floor of our sanctuary in church is old, badly pitted by sparks flying out of the thurible, and, frankly, not too attractive. We are replacing it with a new and much more attractive floor (also donated by anonymous donors). The work will start this week and will take a couple of weeks, during which time the church will not be usable. We will have to do what we did last year when the air-conditioner went out, i.e., have Mass in the lunchroom; not great, but, I assure you, when you see the new floor, you'll think it was worth it!

3. **NEW PHONES** - A new phone system has been installed in the parish offices. They're cheaper, more efficient, and state-of-the-art. Combined with a new package, they should save us money (a lot).

4. **WE ARE IN THE CELL PHONE BUSINESS** - Speaking of phones, we have finally, after several months of negotiations, signed a lease with a cell phone company to have a tower built on our parish grounds. This tower, which will be constructed on the southeast corner of the soccer field (probably some time next fall), will stand about 120 feet, with some support structures at its base. It will bring to our parish a minimum of \$12,000 annually, a possibility of up to \$20,000 (based on how much equipment they are able to load onto it; as they add equipment, they have to pay us more). A big part of the negotiations were internal with our own parish leadership (financial, sports, parish council, etc.), discussing among ourselves, discerning the best location and deal. We are all now on board and agree that this is in the best interest of our parish. More later.

5. **BVM STATUE** - The statue of our Blessed Mother which stands astride the Lady Shrine in our church is going to get an upgrade. She is going to get a corona/halo in back of her head to enhance the manifestation of her sanctity. She will be gone from a church for a couple of weeks while the work is being done.

6. **FLOWERS** - This is an ongoing thing around here, so much so that North County people have stopped going to Shaw's Garden because there's no need to; all the floral beauty they could want can be found right here at St. Angela*! Our green-thumbed horticulturalists have done it again. They've knocked themselves out to make our parish gardens even better than ever before, *and they succeeded!* The flowers look great now, but just wait for when they all go into full bloom: the best is yet to come!

* *There's a slight bit of hyperbole connected with this statement, but it could be true!*

Please join us Friday, June 15th, at 7:00 PM in the lunchroom for the showing of **Messenger of the Truth**. Narrated by Martin Sheen **Messenger of the Truth** tells the remarkable, true story of Blessed Father Jerzy Popieluszko, whose faith, conviction and courage inspired the people of Poland to stand against the oppressive Communist rule of the 1980s. In his powerful sermons, Father Jerzy spoke about human rights, railed against injustice and tyranny, and advocated for truth and freedom. In 1984, at 35, he was kidnapped and martyred by the Polish security police. He is celebrated internationally and an estimated 20 million people have visited the church of St. Stanislaus Kostka in Warsaw where he preached and is buried. Father Popieluszko was beatified on June 6, 2010, and a miracle attributed to his intercession is under investigation as part of his canonization process.

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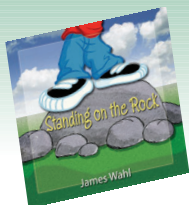
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
