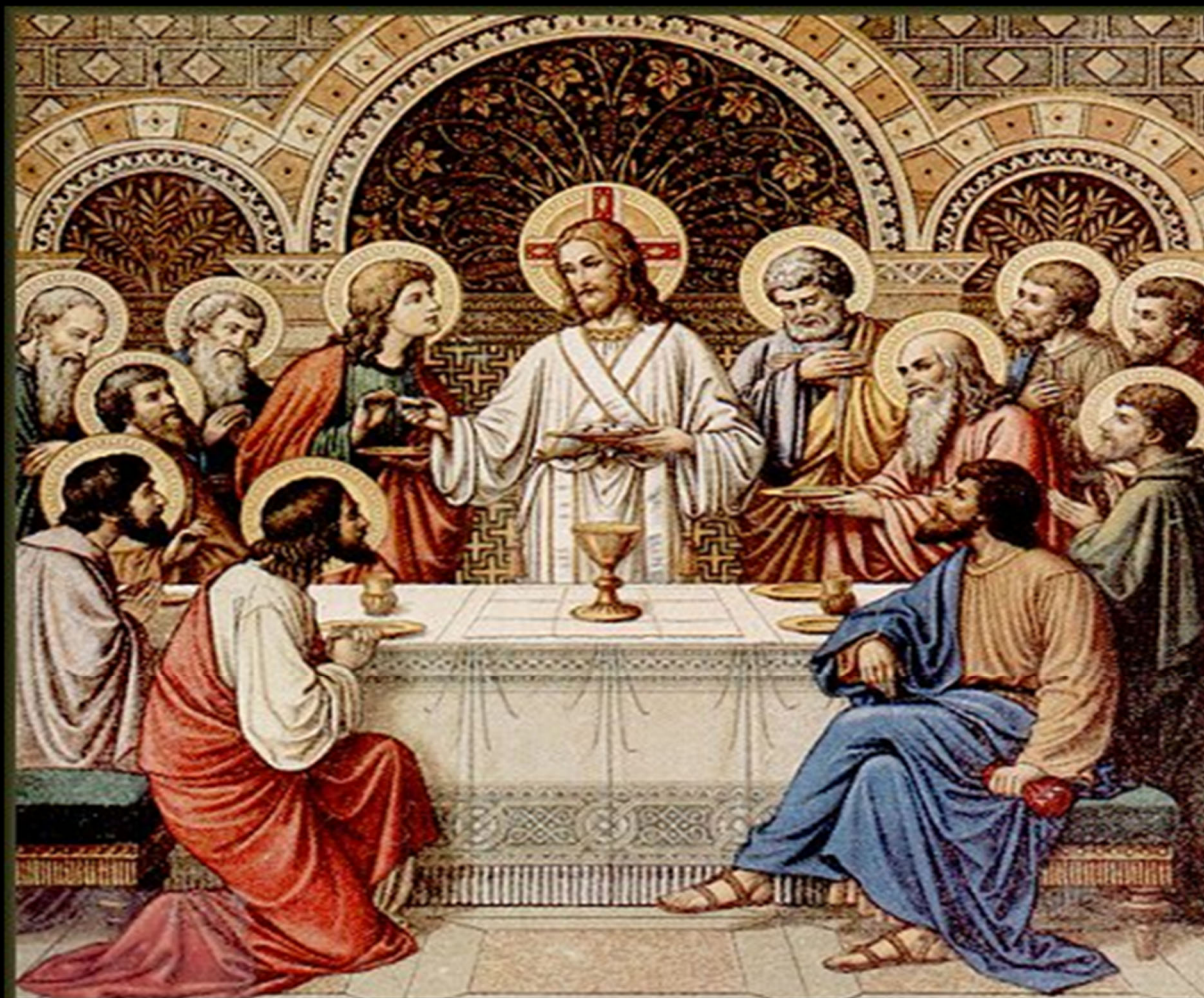

From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS!

PASTOR ON THE EAST COAST

It's time for your pastor to go sponging off his relatives on the East Coast of the USA again, so I'll be departing here this Friday and be back for the Masses of the weekend of June 16/17. In my absence, our sturdy and saintly deacon, Deacon Joe Kroutil, will have a daily Communion service. If there's a funeral or sacramental emergency, we'll contact one of my brother priests at a neighboring parish. Everything else will continue as usual (Tuesday adoration included). Next weekend, however...

...LA SALETTE MISSIONARIES COMING TO ST. ANGELA'S

Covering the next weekend Masses will be Fr. Edwin Ariola of the La Salette Missionary Fathers. As you know, every year every parish of the Archdiocese is visited by a missionary priest. This has a two-fold purpose. First, it helps to keep the laity abreast of the Church's missionary activity, with special attention to its difficulties, successes, and needs. Second, (and related to its needs) it gives the faithful a chance to take an active part in Christ's great mandate to the Church to "Go forth and teach all nations" by their financial support. Fr. Ariola will be taking up a collection, therefore, and I ask you to be as generous with him as you have always been in the past.

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

The Eucharist is at the heart of our Catholic lives. Without it, we simply cannot hope to thrive in the life that God calls us to live. He empowers us to live that life through all the sacraments, of course, but through one in particular: the Sacrament of His Body and Blood. For a thousand years there was never any serious doubt that the Eucharist really was Jesus' True Body and Blood. Then a man named Berengarius came along disputing it all. Although he apparently wound up embracing the true faith in the end, he caused enough controversy that the Church, in specific reaction to him, did something she had never done before or since, namely, she canonized one explicit explanation of one of her mysteries to be the authentic one: TRANSUBSTANTIATION. Taking that explanation to heart, and in response to a whole series of Eucharistic miracles happening around the world, the Church came up with the great feast we celebrate now, so that the faithful may be confirmed in their belief that Jesus is really present in the Eucharist and be given a chance to express that devotionally. This is done with a great procession, with as much solemnity, pomp, and flat-out *Romanità* as we can muster. The procession starts at Sacred Heart at 1:00PM and proceeds through Old Town Florissant to the Old St. Ferdinand Shrine. (It's a very walkable half-mile trek, downhill most of the way.) Refreshments at the end and shuttle service back to Sacred Heart, too.

GERMAN FOOD NIGHT

It all happens this Tuesday, when *der Koch-Meister*, Herr Don Krause, works his magic to honor St. Boniface (patron of the Germans) with an evening of *gemuetlichkeit* and great eating! It starts at 4:30PM and goes to about 7:00. You can eat in the air-conditioned comfort of the lunchroom or in the pleasant Florissant breezes under the tent or the shade of the trees. There'll be German music, German beer, and a splendid time for all! (By the way, the Germans wear red on June 5!)

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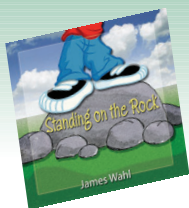
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
