From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT AUGUST IS THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT!

THE SIXTH CHAPTER OF JOHN; THE HOLY EUCHARIST

How beautiful and fitting it is that in this month, which, in our Catholic piety, is dedicated to the Blessed Sacrament, we have the Sunday Gospel readings from the sixth chapter of John, Jesus' discourse on the Bread of Life! This week, I will speak of it as the "Holy Eucharist" and why we call it that. On the subsequent Sundays, the topic will be: the Real Presence, the Blessed Sacrament (and Holy Communion), and Transubstantiation. I hope it will be fruitful for all.

FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF OUR LADY

The Feast of our Lady's Assumption falls on a Wednesday this year (Aug. 15, a week from this coming Wednesday), and so it is a holy day of obligation. I will try to make the Masses of that feast as accessible as possible by having the usual 8:00AM Mass on Aug. 15, and evening Mass on the evening before and on the day itself. (The Tuesday evening Mass at 7:00 will preclude the usual P. H. Devotions that night.)

DANNY KUEHLER CONCERT

You definitely don't want to miss the performance this next Sunday afternoon of our former parishioner (who has moved on to big things in the world of classical music), Danny Kuehler. Here's the playbill: 1) Piano sonata in A major (D. 664) by Franz Schubert, 2) Two pieces by Isaac Albeniz - Corpus Christi en Seville and Triana, and 3) Piano sonata no. 8 by Sergei Prokofiev. You don't have to be a long hair to appreciate his performance; in the live and intimate setting of our lunchroom the music takes on a vibrancy that you don't get from a recording, or even in a concert hall. It's free and open to all (but be assured, a hat will be passed!).

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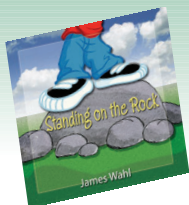
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
