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From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitos:

REMEMBER THAT DECEMBER IS THE MONTH OF MARY'S IMMACULATE CONCEPTION! ADVENT

I hope that by now you've received my Advent/Christmas letter with the schedule of Confessions, Masses, and Devotions for the two seasons of Advent and Christmas. (I also included a special gift of the really spiffy refrigerator magnet that has most of the parish info printed on it...a welcome addition to the front of your fridge!) Advent & Christmas really are discrete entities and need to be observed as such. I'm very happy that the annual celebration of solemn Vespers on the four Sunday evenings of Advent has been so well received at our parish. They will, of course, begin this evening. I think that Vespers is just about the best way to connect with the spirit of the season, and it becomes a family tradition that even the little ones enjoy and will remember all through their lives. Plan on joining us each Sunday (and bring the kids and grandkids!!)

JOLLY OLD ST. NICHOLAS

A big part of the charm of Advent is its peculiar and particular saints. This Friday is the feast of St. Nicholas (a.k.a., "Santa Claus"). Traditionally, either stockings are hung on the fireplace or shoes are placed by the door for the saint to fill with treats for the well-behaved. I don't think you can ever get too old for these hallowed, old traditions, and that is especially true with regard to the spirit of generous giving that the saint personifies. Come to Mass that day and learn from a master what Advent is all about!

STAFF XMAS GIFT

Every year our parish takes up a collection to make a gift to the faithful workers who make up our wonderful parish staff. I have never been part of parish like ours, where all who work here give as kindly and share their gifts in selfless service of the parish as our good people here at SAM! And on top of that, they do a great job of maintaining the parish facilities and caring for the people. 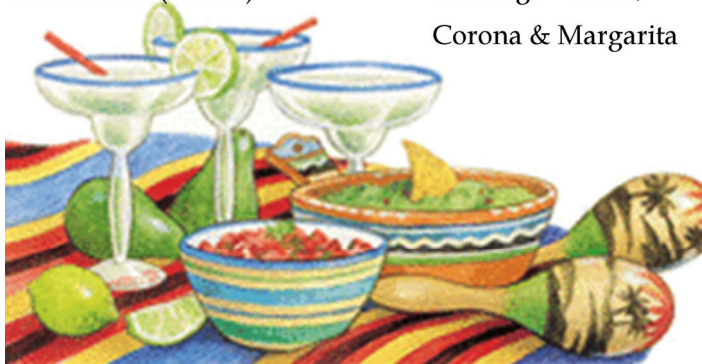

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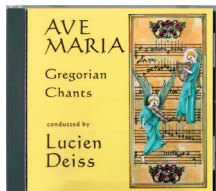
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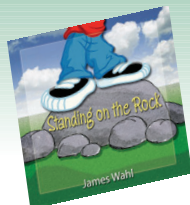
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
