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From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS!

FAITH OF OUR FATHERS

In survey after survey, the result is always the same. It should surprise no one, but it always seems to catch avatars of the New Age, the adherents to Flip Wilson's famous "Church-of-What's- Happenin'-Now", off-guard. It's this: kids need BOTH mothers AND fathers; not "two mommies", not surrogates performing the roles of moms & dads, but actual parents. So many of the problems that face so many of our young men and women, but particularly the young men, flow from the absence of a dad in their homes. Worst of all are those who have no idea who their father is. I just read of a survey which concluded that the single most important person in the faith of children is their father. Surprised? The famous sociologist/anthropologist, Will Durant (who died in 1981 having just turned 97), identified 21 great civilizations of past that are long gone, and, for 19 of them, the cause of death was internal rot caused by their playing fast and loose with the identity and definition of the family. Why can't we learn this lesson? Why do let the least informed and lowest motivated of those among us (i.e., the courts and the Congress) make all the decisions for us in these matters? Right now, every government program that is supposed to "help" the family is actually working toward its destruction. Does anyone doubt this? Even if the motives are pure, that doesn't verify or justify the results, which are deplorable, and for which we will have absolute hell to pay. The solution? We need our dads to be dads and for dads to be respected and cherished for the indispensable asset that they are. On this Fathers' Day, let's make that happen!

A NEW LID FOR OUR PARISH CHURCH

The results are in and we have a winner! The color of the shingles of our new roof has been chosen by the will and mandate of the people. *Vox populi, vox Dei!* A large sample of our new color is on display in the lunchroom. Now that that's out of the way, we have to pay for it. It will cost about \$30,000, and for that we will get a roof that will last another 30 years and fix the dip in the roof above the sanctuary (on the outside; the inside will still look the same). The work will commence about the middle of July and should only take a few days. MASS IN A BEAUTIFUL SPOT

About once a year, our parish organizes a pilgrimage to the wilds of Cottleville, to the family chapel of Dr. Terry Piper and his wife, Judy, to offer a special Mass in the beautiful chapel they added onto their home. Essentially, there is no difference, it's all a question of usage and connotation; “spirit” is neutral and simply means a non-corporeal entity, whereas “ghost” has taken on the connotation of hobgoblins, hauntings, and old Boris Karloff movies 5. Of course, in many places, but most directly in the very end of St. Matthew's Gospel when Jesus instructs the Apostles to baptize in the name of the “Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit” 6. “Glory (be) to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit...” 7. Unitarian 8. No; they are all equally God 9. A defined truth which we are obliged to believe, even though it's beyond our capacity to understand it fully 10. Hypostasis, or “hypostatic union”

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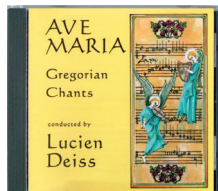
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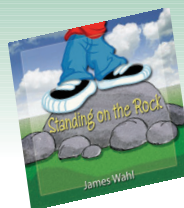
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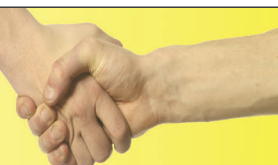
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
