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From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS!

FOR A HOLE IN OUR ROOF OR A WHOLE NEW ROOF...

As I mentioned last Sunday, the Grand Old Lady of our parish, namely, our parish church, needs a new hat. The current roof, as we can best reckon, is about 30 years old, which means that we pretty much sucked all the usefulness out of it and every penny we ever spent on it we got back in dry, leak-proof service. It is, *ergo*, time for a new one. We've signed a contract with Geissler Roofing of Belleville, IL, who have done a lot of work in our area and have earned an excellent reputation, to do the work. It will cost us right at \$30,000 (and last 30-40 years). For that money, they will replace all the shingles and fill in any gaps or weak points. Most of all, they will straighten out, to extent that it is possible without doing a major engineering job, the dip in the central spine of the roof in its last ten feet as it makes its way to its highest point on the back wall of the sanctuary. We are taking up a special collection to try to raise the \$30,000, too, so please take one of the special envelopes printed up just for this purpose, or else use one of your own envelopes and write "NEW ROOF" on the outside of it, and drop it in the collection basket, or at the parish office either in person or by mail (checks payable to "St. Angela Merici").

Since the new shingles are offered in many different colors, I thought it expedient to let the parish at large select the new color in the American Way, i.e., by popular vote. I invite you to stop by the lunchroom after Mass today (if you haven't already done so), check out the sample panel with its 16 varieties, and vote for your top two favorites. Keep in mind that the ballot is weighted; your first choice receives 2 points, your second choice only one. (Voting ends this weekend.) We will tabulate the results, and if there is no clear winner, we will have a run-off election next weekend between the top two vote-getters. So proceed to the hustings and make your will known. (Work on the new roof won't commence until later on this summer and should only take two or three days.)

ADULT FAITH FORMATION NEWS

Our committee met the other day and we've come up with some great activities and exercises to enhance the spiritual growth and well-being of our parishioners. The next thing on the docket is the pilgrimage to the Pipers' chapel in Cottleville on Friday, June 21, at 7:00PM. We'll either meet here and carpool over together, or those who know the way can just meet us there. In any case, all are welcome. Typically, we gather at Madison's Café for dinner afterward. If you're going to dine with us at Madison's, call the parish office and let us know (838-6565) (you can also call for directions). Later on in the summer, we will have another tour of the historic churches of St. Louis. This would be a day excursion as we visit three of the most beautiful and historic churches of our archdiocese, churches that ordinarily would not be open and available for a visit. We will stop in some nice place for lunch, and the date is TBD. Also TBD is an extended pilgrimage/bus tour to either Cardinal Burke's shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe in LaCrosse, Wisconsin, or St. Meinrad's Archabbey in southern Indiana. Either one would be a three-day, two-night affair with plenty of time for prayer, reflection, education and celebration of the sacraments. The Catholic Family Movie Night Series is being suspended for the summer, as is my catechism class; both will return in the fall. There will be plenty of advance notice for the TBD's, so stay tuned...

THE SACRED BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

In just two weeks, the feast that celebrates the grand mystery of the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist will take place. As I mentioned here last week, the great annual Florissant Corpus Christi Procession will take place again on that day, as usual, but with one big exception: this year it will occur in the relative cool of the evening instead of the blazing hot noon-day sun. It starts at Sacred Heart at 7:00PM; plan to be there! (Hot dogs & brats served by the Knights of Columbus after.)
