THE PATRON OF OUR ARCHDIOCESE

August 25 is the feast day of the patron saint of our city and archdiocese, St. Louis, that being the day on which he departed this world in 1270. Since his feast falls on Sunday this year, the festivities of his memorial supersede the usual Sunday observance (i.e., the 21st Sunday of Ordinary Time). And so at all of this weekend's Masses, we here in Florissant will celebrate the feast of patron, St. Louis IX, King of France. It's always a treat for us to honor our patron, especially since he was such a great man. He was a true Catholic monarch and a true Christian gentleman, a warrior for the faith and defender of orthodoxy. He excelled in practically every aspect of royal life, leaving behind a legacy of which we can all be proud. When Notre Dame burned last spring, the two things they rushed to save first were the Crown of Thorns (which St. Louis brought to France) and the relics of St. Louis himself; that's how precious these items are. We will have our own relic of the saintly King of France available for your veneration this weekend.

NEW RAILING IN CHURCH

I hope you take time to notice the new railings that accompany the steps of our sanctuary, easing the way up to and down from the old for old codgers like me. They have been donated in memory of Kathleen Willmann, who passed away on April 4, 2018. 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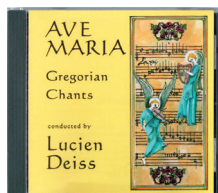
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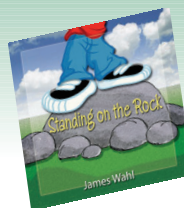
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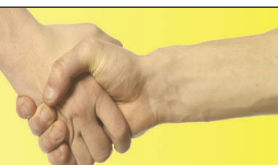
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
