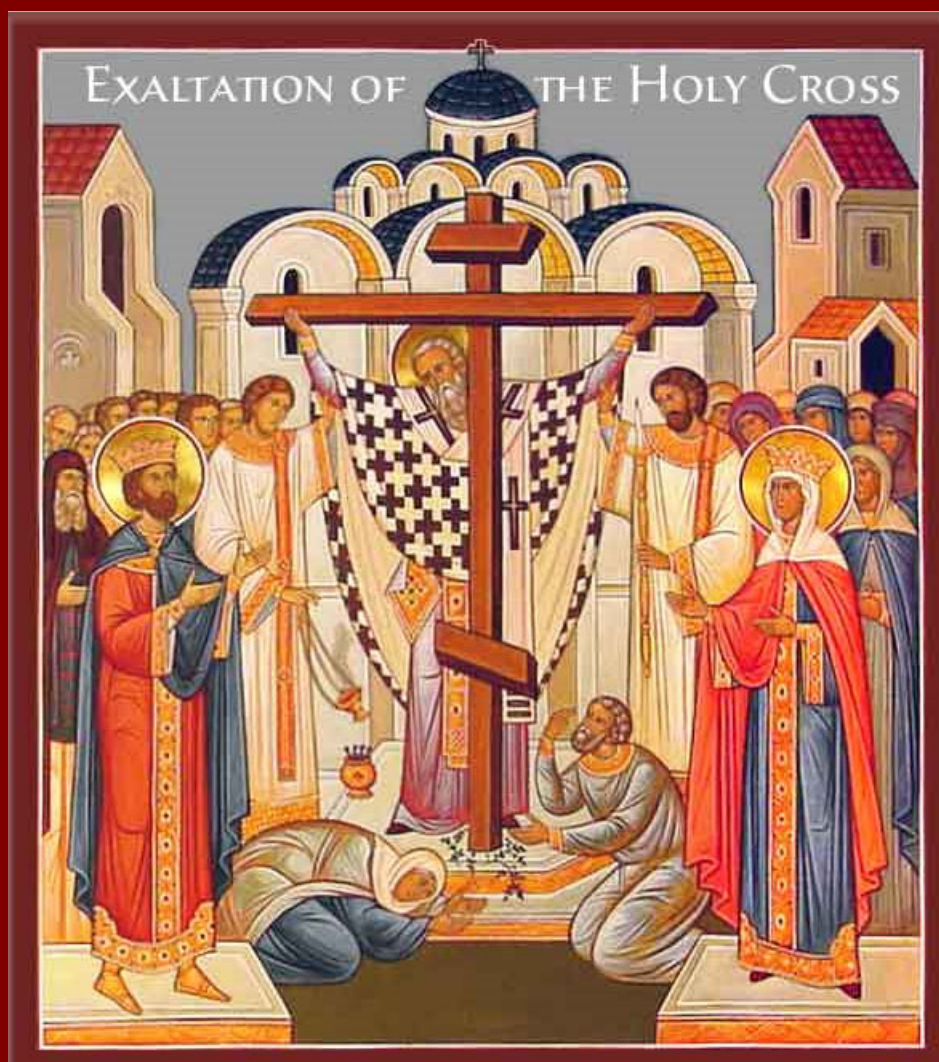

This Thursday, September 12, is the Feast of the Holy Name of Mary, which celebrates the victory of the Catholic forces at the Siege of Vienna in 1683, through the intercession and invocation of Mary's holy name. DEVELOPMENT OF THE UNBORN BABY—FIRST MONTH

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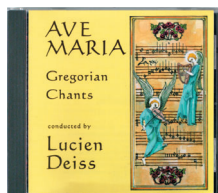
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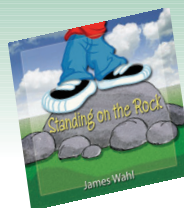
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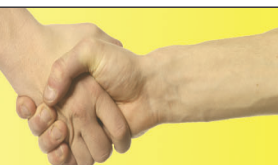
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
