From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT JANUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY CHILDHOOD OF JESUS!

GOD IS PRO-LIFE!

I will be leaving after the 8:00AM Mass this Wednesday to head up to our Nation's Capital for the annual March for Life. I will be joined by a number of other members of our parish and about 750,000 of our fellow countrymen who will brave winter's blast and great distance to raise a cry of protest against the Culture of Death and its most cherishedly-held sacrament, abortion. I'm telling you this for several reasons, not the least of which is that you will not hear about the March from the usual "mainstream media" outlets (not unless, of course, another group of Catholic High School young men get assaulted by another group of weirdos, and the Fake-News media outlets can use the episode to make the Catholics look bad again.) Pray for us, pray for our nation. There are great signs that the country is beginning to see things our way, so now is the time to re-double our efforts to promote the cause. ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2019

In an effort to be good stewards of the contributions made to the SVDP Society, we continue to make home visits in teams of two Vincentians to assess the needs of our neighbors.

- From January 1 to December 31, our members made 255 home visits. In addition to the home visits, 83 contacts were made by phone. There were 958 persons helped by single or multiple visits to a household.
- There were 721 Vincentian hours involved in those visits.
- Assistance was given to 110 families to avoid Spire disconnection.
- Assistance was given to 148 families to avoid Ameren disconnection.
- Assistance was given to 18 families to avoid MO-AM water disconnection.
- Through the Beds for Neighbors program we were able to get beds for 19 families.
- We were able to help 4 families with used car purchases through the Car program.
- With help from the Bridges Fund of the Main Council Office we were able to help 30 families with rent assistance to avoid eviction.
- In addition to the above assistance, we were able to give Thrift Store Vouchers to 51 families to help with clothing & household items. We accumulated credit for these vouchers because of your generous response when the SVDP truck was at St. Angela’s.
- We continue to be one of the largest contributors to the TEAM food pantry with our monthly Food Drives which also allows us to take food packages directly to our neighbors.

We are very grateful to the parishioners of St. Angela Merici for their financial contributions the Food Drive donations & the contributions to the Spring clothing & household truck collection. We appreciate your support for this ministry.

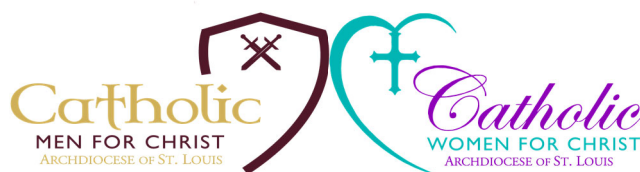
