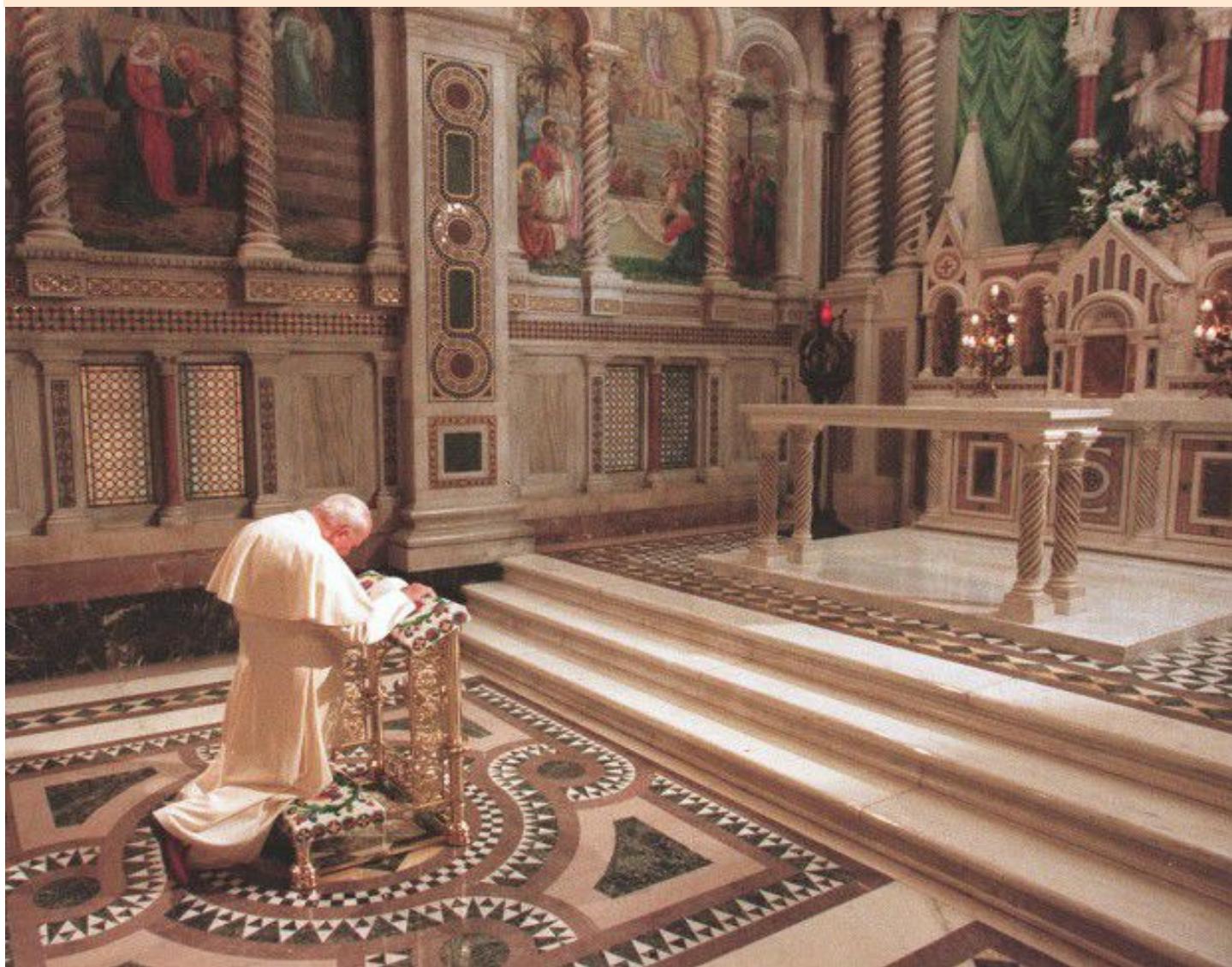

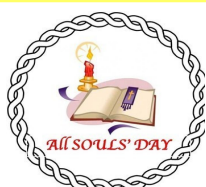

From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT OCTOBER IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY!

THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY

By all means, continue to *pray your rosary!* Why? Your parish needs the prayers, your country needs the prayers, our world needs the prayers, and *you* need the prayers!

ELECTION NOVENA

I mentioned here earlier that our parish was going to have a novena of prayers for the national election. Here's the plan: it will start on Sunday, October 25, and take place after all the Masses, i.e., after the three Sunday morning Masses and the 8:00AM weekday Masses, leading up to Nov. 3. The day before the election, Monday Nov. 2, is All Souls' Day. That being the case, there will be three Masses that day: 6:30AM, 8:00AM, and as part of our holy hour at 7:00PM. Mass will begin the holy hour at 7:00PM, and then prayers will follow until 8:00PM. The novena prayers will last 10-15 minutes; we will wait for all the non-participants in the novena to leave church, and then will commence the novena prayers. Does our country need the prayers? Are you kidding?

RCIA FOR CATHOLICS

"RCIA for *Catholics*? I thought it was for non-Catholics who wanted to become Catholic!" Well, yes, that's so, but every year when I conduct these classes, there's usually a "cradle Catholic or two who joins us for the lessons. The RCIA is, essentially, a crash-course in Catholicism and is aimed directly at adults. It's a chance for many whose last exposure to a formal Catholic religion class was when they were in grade school to learn the faith from a distinctly adult perspective. It's not as in-depth as my catechism class (where we explore the subtleties and nuances of Catholic theology), but it does cover *everything*, from Albigensianism to Zoroastrianism (and we have a good time, as well). I don't have any candidates for conversion this year, but some parishioners have expressed an interest in being part of an RCIA class, anyway, and I'm amenable. The days and times are flexible, but I'm thinking of meeting on Mondays around 4:00PM and going until 5:00 or 5:30 (we can change and adapt that to meet everybody's needs). If you'd like to be in that number, let me know ASAP!

POPE ST. JOHN PAUL II

His feast is this coming Thursday, and his chair (used by him on his St. Louis visit in 1999) is on display in church. You may sit in it (and have your picture taken) if you wish; it's a 2nd-class relic!

of St. Louis) and is said to have been Meredith Willson's inspiration for the character "Professor Harold Hill" in his hit musical, "The Music Man" 2. He was the last married pope (d. 872AD) 3. It's a fancy name for a monstrance (the vessel that holds the large host in Eucharistic Adoration) 4. "Ad Maiorem Dei Gloriam" ("Toward the Greater Glory of God") - the motto of the Jesuits 5. From King Belshazzar's party, where the sacred vessels were profaned, as recorded in Daniel 5:26 6. St. Cecilia, who sang on the way to her martyrdom 7. Bernard-the Memorare, Hermann-the Salve, Regina 8. Chaplet 9. The "Holy Stairs", now located in Rome across from the Lateran Basilica, but were bought there from Jerusalem, and are said to be the stair that Jesus mounted on His way to the Praetorium 10. Despite many colorful pseudo-definitions, an actual papal bull is a solemn, formal decree from the pope on serious, Church-related matters. They usually come sealed with a lead ball ("bulla", in Latin), whence derives the name.

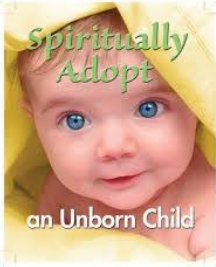

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION

Second month in the development of the unborn baby. Your baby is growing very quickly. He is now 1 ¼ inches long and weighs 1/30 of an ounce. IMPORTANT NOTICE

For Every employee, Clergy and volunteers.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. **This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service.** For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to **www.preventandprotectstl.org** to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button. Enter the **passcode stlprotect**. Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314 -838-6565 with any questions or for further assistance. This should take about an hour to do. Thanks in advance for taking care of this.
