The Ursulines (of Owensboro, Ky.), Sr. Joseph Mary serving as first principal 6. June 19, 1964 7. September, 1965 (163 students, grades 1-4 only), using only the classrooms that are now the parish offices and meeting rooms 8. In the rectory on Galaxie (weekdays in the garage, Sundays in the basement), then at Black Jack School (now Keeven School)
