GAUDETE SEMPER IN DOMINO! (THE ROSE-COLORED SUNDAY)

Both of the Church's penitential seasons (Advent & Lent) have a rose-colored Sunday strategically placed right after the half-way point of the season. By that I mean that the priest wears a rose-colored vestment to express modified rejoicing that the penitential season is more than half over, and the big feast, in anticipation of whose celebration we've been doing penance, is near at hand. And so on this Third Sunday of Advent (known traditionally as *Gaudete Sunday*), as we light the rose candle on the wreath, we do a little cork-popping and rejoice in a modified way that the Messiah's coming is nigh!

CHRISTMAS MASSES; RESERVATIONS?

Historically, the most crowded Mass at any parish in the course of a year is the Christmas Eve Vigil Mass. It has always been the most popular and best-attended one at every parish at which I've ever served in the 42 years I've been a priest *by far*, and our parish is no exception. Even though this is a most abnormal year, I still anticipate the 5:00PM Mass on Dec. 24 to be the best attended, but I don't know to what extent. I've had a lot of people come up to me and tell me that such-and-such parish is taking *reservations* for that Mass, thus limiting (and controlling) the size of the crowds. Making calculations based on my seven years here at St. Angela and the Mass attendance trend of the past eight months, I don't see a need to do that here. But I might be wrong! All I can say is that if you really want to attend that Mass, get here early. If we need to, we can overflow into the vestibule and lunchroom (it's not the Heavenly Jerusalem of liturgical practice, but we've already made some weird accommodations already this year). Or else, if you arrive late and are worried about the size of the crowd, just leave and come back for the 10:00PM Mass (or one of the Christmas morning Masses).

VESPERS

I have been greatly edified by the great spirit shown at the Sunday Vespers. We're offering this beautiful service again this evening. Be there (7:00PM, in church)!
