#### FOUR CANDLES BURNING

As we see all four candles of the Advent Wreath are lit, it's the surest sign of all that the coming of the Lord is nigh! In these last few days of this season of preparation, the question we are all to ask ourselves arises: Am I ready? The Bridegroom comes, is there enough oil in my lamp? If you must answer that question in the negative, be of good cheer. There's still time to get your house in order. Check the schedule at the bottom of this column for the extra times for Confession.

#### **CHRISTMAS MASSES; BE WARY**

As I wrote last week, we're not making any special plans for controlling access to the various Christmas Masses. I'm relying on each one of you to be adult, exercise discretion, and take charge of your own well-being and that of others, too. I know that many people like to attend the Vigil Mass on Christmas Eve (at 5:00), but if you can't be there extra early for that Mass, then consider another arrangement. These are extraordinary circumstances and if we just defer to one another a bit, I think it can be a blessed Christmas. The two Christmas Day Masses are usually rather sparse, so instead of even trying for the Vigil Mass, you might just simply alter your usual customs this year in light of the unusual conditions and plan on coming Christmas morning.

This has been a rough year on everybody, but I have been singularly edified by the way our parishioners have made the best of it in so many ways. Despite not being able to attend Mass, many of our people have kept current with their weekly contributions. I don't like to talk money; my attitude is that you're all adults and you know what it takes to keep our parish going.
