## From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

## REMEMBER THAT DECEMBER IS THE MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION!

#### THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION, HOLY PATRONESS OF OUR LAND

Back in 1846, the bishops of the United States got together to make some important decisions regarding the practice of the faith in our land. One of the orders of business was to choose a patron saint for the United States. For the Irish, the choice was a no-brainer; whom could they possibly have chosen besides St. Patrick? Indeed, for most of Europe, one man could be identified, like Patrick, as *the* apostle of their country. Such was not so for us. At that time, however, a wonderful spirit was at work in the Church. The Blessed Mother Herself was appearing to humble souls and, while speaking to them, spoke freely of Her Immaculate Conception. In those days, the Church did teach that the Mother of God, the New Eve, had, indeed, been conceived without sin, but did not teach that as a dogma of the faith. Now She Herself was proclaiming that what we had always suspected to be true was a *fact*. And so the bishops of the U.S. *unanimously* chose Her, as the Immaculate Conception, to protect and defend America. Because of that, we celebrate the festival day of that great event as a holy day of obligation. This coming Tuesday, Dec. 8, is that festival day, and so we will have a special schedule of Masses, Monday, Dec. 7, 5:00PM, and Tuesday, Dec. 8, at 8:00AM and 7:00PM (this 7:00 Mass takes the place of the usual Tuesday evening devotions). Jesus entrusted the whole human race to her motherly care as He hung upon the Cross; we Americans have an even greater claim on her, and the fruits are bountiful. Come and celebrate as Americans our special privilege!

#### **VESPERS**

We were sort of flying by the seat of our pants last Sunday, but our celebration of the Vespers of the First Sunday of Advent was beautiful and very well attended! We're doing it again this evening for the Second Sunday! Be there!

#### CHRISTMAS FLOWERS

It's overwhelmingly obvious that our people love every aspect of our parish, including our parish buildings and grounds. (Just look at how lovingly and skillfully our magnificent gardens are tended each year!) In addition to that, however, is the level of care and attention given to the decoration of our parish church for all the major feasts. This year will be no different. We plan to go ALL OUT, PEDAL TO THE METAL, THROTTLE TO THE FIREWALL all the way to make our parish church a worthy spot for the Savior of the World to be born!
