**REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!**

### **PALMS**

Ash Wednesday fast approacheth, and with it the start of Lent. In preparation, we ask you to bring up your old palms from last Palm Sunday and drop them in the box in the vestibule of the church in the next couple of weeks. They will be properly burned and then the resultant ashes will be used on Ash Wednesday to remind us of our mortality.

### **LENTER SPEAKER SERIES**

For the past several years now, our parish has been blessed to be able to sponsor (in conjunction with Catholic Radio) a Lenten speaker series. This year, we have another good one. ### NEW MOM'S AND BABIES THANK YOU

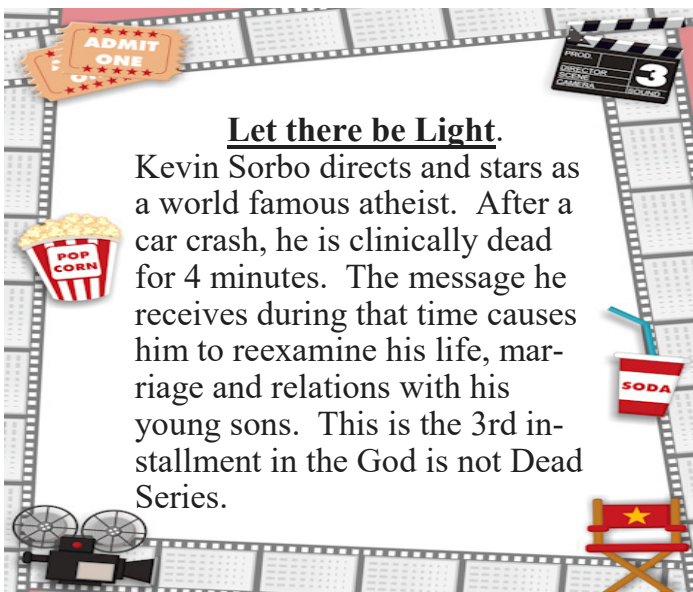
The Director and one of the volunteers at Birthright St. Charles were thrilled with our parishioners' donations for the
