### From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

I know that rumors are probably spreading like crazy around the parish with regard to the state of my health, so let me make it clear what is going on. This past Monday (April 13), I came down with a fever, which, at its apex, reached 101.5 degrees. That only lasted until the next morning (Tuesday, April 14). I called the Corona hotline for testing and they told me that there was no need for that, but that I should quarantine myself for the next 7 days (with 3 days of being fever-free). This I am doing. Was it Corona? Who knows? The only symptom I had (besides just a general yucky feeling) was the fever; there was no sore throat, no respiratory issues, no joint ache, etc. I'm writing this on Tuesday (April 14), and I don't feel terribly bad. My temperature has gotten back down to a normal range, and I'm starting to get some energy back.

Until further notice, church will be closed and all live streamed Masses are suspended. Please continue to check the website for additional updates.

If it was Corona, then, at least for me, it was a paper tiger, which is not to say that we can just brush the whole thing off as a big and baseless scare. In any event, please don't stop the prayers (I can always use them!)

#### PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to

www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button. Enter the passcode stlprotect. Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314 -838-6565 with any questions or for further assistance.
