### REMEMBER THAT APRIL IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY EUCHARIST AND MAY IS THE MONTH OF OUR LADY!

#### MUCH HAS BEEN GOING ON...

...since the last time we've had public Mass here in the Archdiocese, and especially so here at your parish, under the protection of our heavenly patroness, Angela Merici. The first thing you'll notice when you return will be our newly-refurbished parking lot. Although it had been in generally good shape, there were quite a number of small cracks through which water had been seeping and undermining the chat foundations. Those have all been sealed tight. Furthermore, the entire blacktop has been sealed, giving it a "newly-painted", fresh look. Since the sealing covered up all the old lines that delineated each individual parking spot, it was re-lined as well. And it looks great, like a brand-spanking new parking lot. It cost us about \$22,000, so any help you can give us toward that would go down very smooth!

We also have some changes for the sanctuary of church in the pipeline, too. I hope to have them all in place by the time everything opens up again in a couple of weeks, but I'll hold off on talking about them until I'm more certain about the timing. And, of course, the decorations of church for Holy Week and Easter were sensational, exceeding the standard we have set over the past few years. We're still the talk of North County (if not the whole Archdiocese), and our legend is growing!

### WHEN ALL RETURNS TO NORMAL

We're going to have a big, parish-wide celebration, so count on coming. First, whatever Sunday we're allowed to have public Mass will be doughnut Sunday (regardless of the date). Second, there will be some kind of bar-be-cue, dinner or whatever, so that we can catch up with the rest of the folks and find out what's been going on the past month. And third, everything else will return to normal. And rest assured; the minute we can open up again, WE WILL!

### THE FLOWERS THAT BLOOM IN THE SPRING (TRA-LA!)

Or so sang Gilbert and Sullivan, but they were obviously clairvoyant in foreshadowing what would take place here in Florissant, at St. Angela Merici Parish, 130 years later. I'm talking, of course, about our magnificent gardens, which (if they haven't done so already) will soon supplant Shaw's Garden as the number one public display of herb-craft in the world. Our diligent horticulturalists are at it again and doing great stuff. We hope to exceed all previous efforts and show the rest of the community what "The Valley of the Flowers" is really all about! They could use an extra hand (or at least an extra thumb, preferably green), so if you can help, make yourself known!

### **QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC**

In medieval times, a source of recreation and great fun was what was called the "steeplechase". Those sufficiently well-off to be able to afford a horse (and especially those wealthy enough to own a thoroughbred racehorse) would assemble in the courtyard of one town's church and then race to another town, the finish line being that town's church steeple. This would continue until several places had been visited and everybody was tired. Typically, every town had a church and every church had a steeple, which was usually the tallest building in town, and thus was the first thing a visitor would see as he approached the village. ### PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to

www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button. Enter the passcode stlprotect. Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314 -838-6565 with any questions or for further assistance. This should take about an hour to do. Thanks in advance for taking care of this.
