

ICONS AND OILS

As I mentioned last weekend at Mass, we have been busy all the while you were away, and I just wanted to re-iterate here, in written form, what I revealed to you verbally from the pulpit. First, our black-top parking lot was completely re-sealed and striped & painted (and is looking good!). That set us back about \$22,000, but we should be good for another fifteen years or so. Second, we replaced the old icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help (which was just a print) with a hand-painted icon of our patroness, St. Angela Merici. It was executed by local artist (Washington, MO) Josie James, and was donated by an anonymous donor. Also replacing the old MPH icon is our new MPH icon, this one in carved wood. I don't know its origin or how old it is (although it obviously has some years on it), but it had belonged to a friend of mine, Ed Desloge, who was a collector of religious art and who passed away two years ago. His family wanted us to have the icon, and I thought it would fit in well in the spot we have hung it. Last, we finally have an AMBRY! An ambry is simply a repository for the holy oils, i.e., the oils that we use in the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and the Anointing of the Sick (and if we ever had an ordination here, we'd use them for that, too). All the old churches had them, but, for reasons I neither know nor understand, starting around the time our church was built, they stopped putting them in churches. That meant that the oils wound up in a drawer or on a shelf somewhere. Well, liturgists are a cyclical lot, and so it was inevitable that some hotshot liturgist would start the ambry bandwagon rolling and everybody would jump on. That's exactly what happened in the late '90's, so around that time you saw a lot of parishes like ours going way over to the other extreme of making the ambry into almost a second *tabernacle*, putting the oils on display in very elaborate glass cases. Well, no, that's not what it's supposed to be. What we have is just right. Again, it was custom-made for our church (as you can tell) and was also donated anonymously. We thank all those who did such a fine job not just to make our parish church ever more a church, but a beautiful one, at that!

CONFIRMATION TODAY

On this Pentecost Sunday, we will see the perpetuation of what the Apostles experienced in the great sacrament of Confirmation when it is conferred (by special empowerment from the Archbishop) at the 9:30AM Mass on two of our eighth-grade parishioners, Benjamin (Andrew) Burke and Jahnea (Severus) Gates. God bless them and their happy families on this great day!

O COME LET US ADORE HIM!

I really want us to get back to normal as quickly as possible, and one thing that needs to be restore (and improved) is our Tuesday Eucharistic Adoration. even before the pandemic our numbers were starting to slip, and so I'm instigating a campaign to get the faithful of our parish to *commit* to spending an hour or so in adoration of our Eucharistic Lord *every Tuesday*. For the next couple of weekends, you will find a sign-up list in the church vestibule where you can commit yourself to a distinct time. I have broken it down to half-hour segments to make it easier for some, so if you want to spend a full hour, just sign up for two. For example, if you want to adore from 1:00 to 2:00PM, sign up for 1:00-1:30 *and* 1:30-2:00. We cannot expose the Blessed Sacrament unless we know that people will be there to worship, so that's why we're making this extra effort to ensure coverage. (Those who can't make it on Sunday, can call the parish office and sign in with the secretary [838-6565]).

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN This really should include vulnerable adults, also.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are cur**rently in service.** For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button. Enter the **passcode stlprotect**. Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314 -838-6565 with any questions or for further assistance. This should take about an hour to do. Thanks in advance for taking care of this.




St. Louis Friends of Birthright Virtual Run for Life and Learning


