TO PRAY FOR OUR COUNTRY

Next Saturday, July 4, is, of course, the 4th of July, our great national holiday. As is our custom, we will have morning Mass on that day (because it is the first Saturday), but that Mass will be at 9:00AM (because it is the national holiday). It seems to me that our country (and world) can really use the prayers at this time, so I invite and encourage all of you, if you are able and disposed, to come and pray with your fellow citizens.

THAT THE PARISH WILL BE SANCTIFIED

Next Friday, being First Friday, our parish will have its monthly holy hour for the sanctification of the parish. Again, I invite and encourage you to come and take part. It's surprising to me how many of our lifelong Catholics have never made a "holy hour", so if you're one of them, come and find how enriching it is to spend time with the Lord in prayer. In church, from 7:00-8:00PM.

LESSENED RESTRICTIONS

Now that the nation is recovering from the recent pandemic, the Archdiocese has promulgated reduced restrictions for us to follow. We are still asked to wear masks entering and leaving church, but receiving Holy Communion on the tongue is now allowed, with no special procedures, for anyone who wishes to receive that way. If you do wish to receive on the tongue, however, please make your way over to my line (but you don't have to wait until the end).

QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC

This coming Monday (June 29) is the great feast of the two pillars of the Catholic Church, Ss. Peter and Paul. Their feast is of such great importance, that it is a holy day of obligation in the universal Church (even though it's not observed as such in America). ANSWERS: 1. Peter-fisherman, Paul-tent-maker 2. Peter-Capernaum, Paul-Tarsus 3. He was a Roman citizen 4. Peter-crucified (upside down), Paul-decapitated (this, rather than crucifixion, was a perquisite of being a Roman citizen) 5. Both in Rome; Peter, in Nero's Circus, Paul outside the southern walls of the city 6. Peter-on Vatican Hill (adjacent to Nero's Circus), Paul-at a site close to his martyrdom 7. St. John Lateran (in the baldachin above the main altar) 8. St. Mark 9. St. Peter (St. Andrew) 10. They both died during the persecutions of the Emperor Nero, their exact dates being uncertain; St. Peter is fixed at 64AD, St. Paul at 67AD

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who **are currently in service.** For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button.

Enter the **passcode stlprotect.** Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314-838-6565 with any questions or for further assistance. This should take about an hour to do. Thanks in advance for taking care of this.
