#### REMEMBER THAT JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS!

#### THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

Every year, the Church asks us to spend the first two Sundays after Pentecost contemplating the two greatest mysteries of our faith, namely, the mysteries of the Holy Trinity and the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. Today, being Trinity Sunday, we take time to reflect on the incomprehensible and seemingly contradictory truth that God, although one, is, at the same time, three. Belief in this awe-filled truth defies all logic and our only reason for believing it is that God Himself revealed this to us, but now that He has, we rejoice in the fact that God condescended to share this wonderful fact of His nature with us. This sets us apart from the rest of the believing world, who only know one Person of God. And so today we also celebrate the unique privilege we have of having this intimate knowledge of our creator, whom we are honored to be able to call "Our Father".

#### **CORPUS CHRIST PROCESSION**

As of this writing (Wednesday, June 3), I still haven't heard about the annual Corpus Christi Procession in Old Town Florissant. I infer from this that we'll probably have to have our own procession here on our parish grounds of St. Angela Merici. The final, formal word will be given this Sunday in church, but in any case, whether here or there, please plan on attending. It will be in the open air and we will process to shrines set up on the parish grounds for adoration. Ours would start at 1:30PM and last about half an hour.

#### O COME LET US ADORE HIM! (part II)

Speaking of Eucharistic Adoration, the faithful of St. Angela have responded, and we have all the time slots filled for Tuesday, all-day Eucharistic Adoration! That means that we will expose the Blessed Sacrament at the conclusion of the 8:00AM Tuesday Mass and leave it exposed all throughout the day until the final Devotions and Benediction at 7:00PM. During that time, the church will, of course, be open, and *anyone* can come and spend as much or as little time with the Lord as he sees fit. It is necessary, however, that we know that someone will be there, which is why we had the sign-ups. I believe we have enough coverage, but just barely. There are still some gaps where there's only one person signed up. Please check the list on the table behind the last pew in the back of church (and sign up) or call the parish office to let us know what time you'd be available to accommodate.



# PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN This really should include vulnerable adults, also.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who **are currently in service.** For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button.

Enter the **passcode stlprotect.** Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314-838-6565 with any questions or for further assistance. This should take about an hour to do. Thanks in advance for taking care of this.




