

From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT JULY IS THE MONTH OF THE PRECIOUS BLOOD OF JESUS!

STILL BEAUTIFUL

I am always overwhelmed by the love our parishioners have for our community in general and for our parish in particular. They express this in many ways, but one of the most noticeable is the loving care with which our faithful horticulturalists tend our parish gardens. One may think that I'm disposed to use hyperbole in describing their efforts and skills, but that really is not the case. Our gardens truly ought to be called "Shaw's Garden North", the big difference now is that the original Shaw's Garden has been closed to the public for many days, but our gardens are here, on full display, for all to see and enjoy. God bless our green-thumbers! You're the best!

GERMANFEST(?)

In just a couple of years, our parish's annual Germanfest has become a great, fun-for-the-whole-family event, that everybody looks forward to. It's scheduled for the last Saturday of September, and, I hope, that we will still be able to have it. It's three whole months away, and a lot can happen between now and then, but I really would like to go ahead with it, if we can reasonably pull it off. PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN This really should include vulnerable adults, also.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who **are currently in service.** For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button.

Enter the **passcode stlprotect**. Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314 -838-6565 with any questions or for further assistance. This should take about an hour to do. Thanks in advance for taking care of this.
