

From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT AUGUST IS THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT!

GOD THE FATHER

I remind you that at 1:30 this afternoon (Sunday, Aug. 2), our parish will once again be host to the annual Mass in honor of God the Father. This is not a recognized liturgical feast of the Universal Church, but is the product of a private revelation from God the Father in 1932 to Mother Eugenia Ravasio in Italy. That puts it exactly where the celebration of the feast of the sacred Body and Blood of Christ (now known as "Corpus Christi") was after it had been revealed to St. Juliana of Liege in the 13th century. We will use the liturgy of the 18th Sunday of Ordinary Time, but with a special emphasis on the Fatherhood of God. All are welcome, and it will satisfy your Sunday obligation.

KEEPING CURRENT

However wrong-headed, counterproductive, and maybe even injurious the Covid guidelines may be, we all have to live with them in order to stay open because they have the force of law. Sam Page, the St. Louis County Covid czar, has just issued new guidelines, dragging us backward. Having read these, I have determined that they will require *no changes* in our current practice. The rule is no more than 25% of the building's capacity. Well, our parish church's capacity is 550, and we have not been getting as many as 137 people at any of our Masses. I know that this is a concern for many, and so I recommend that if you are worried about the Mass' being too well -attended, then come to one of the later Masses on Sunday (9:30 or, especially, 11:30), where the numbers are lower. The members of the congregation must still be masked while in church. Yeesh!

Also, as I mentioned last week, the parish is relying on your good nature and sense of responsibility to keep current, too, with your contributions both to the parish and the ACA (there are forms in the vestibule of church for the ACA, which is being taken through the mail this year).


BIG FEAST DAY!

This coming Thursday, August 6, is the great feast of the Lord's Transfiguration. So plan on coming to the 8:00AM Mass and, who knows? Maybe we might have some kind of politically correct, socially distant celebration afterward! 

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN For Every employee, Clergy and volunteers.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**. Everyone ministering to minors and vulnerable adults (clergy, employees and volunteers) in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system before December 31, 2020. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. In addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please go to www.preventandprotectstl.org to register. Click "Register" below the LOG IN button. Enter the **passcode stlprotect**. Select the type of location where you are a volunteer or employee. Select the specific location by name: St. Angela Merici Parish. Contact Linda Brindley, our parish Child Safety Coordinator, at 314 -838 -6565 with any questions or for further assistance. This should take about an hour to do. Thanks in advance for taking care of this.
