

SAYING HELLO

This Tuesday, August 25, will see the installation of the 10th archbishop of St. Louis, Abp. Mitchell Rozanski. He's 62 years old and comes to us from Baltimore by way of Springfield, MA where he has served as bishop for the last six years. Because of the Wuhan Flu restrictions, attendance at the installation at the Basilica is by invitation only (although it will be broadcast live on EWTN and also on the Basilica's live-streaming). It starts at 2:00PM. The date was chosen because it is the feast of our archdiocesan primary patron saint, St. Louis IX of France. This is a great turning of the page of the history of the archdiocese, and we welcome our new archbishop. Please pray for him, and for his predecessor, Abp. Carlson, who now enters retirement.

SAYING GOOD-BYE

As we welcome the new archbishop, we must, sadly, say farewell to a good and faithful friend, our music director, Pat Buchanan. Pat has organized the liturgical music at our parish and conducted the parish choir for many, many years, and we're going to miss her terribly. We wish her well as she leaves our parish, and offer her the support of our prayers.

QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC

Let's have another grab-bag of Catholic (especially locally Catholic) odds & ends, a virtual *pot pourri* of popery, if you will. See if you can name:

- 1. The alumnus of German St. Vincent Orphanage, DuBourg H.S., Cardinal Glennon College and St. Louis U. who invented the process of investing through "index funds".
- 2. The site in May, 1917, of the first-ever in world history "cocktail party".
- 3. The Catholic University whose quarterback threw the first-ever forward pass on Sept. 5, 1906 (it was incomplete).
- 4. The St. Louis Catholic family whose members invented the kindergarten and gave Dred Scott and his family their freedom.

- 6. The St. Louis parish soccer team that won the bronze medal at the 1904 Olympics.
- 7. The St. Louis native who saved Michelangelo's most famous sculpture, the *Pieta* of the Vatican, from further damage when attacked by the lunatic, Laszlo Toth, on May 21, 1972.
- 8. The great American playwright whose funeral Mass was at the Cathedral Basilica, and who was then interred in Calvary Cemetery in 1983.
- 9. The former band teacher at DuBourg H.S. who recorded the 1960's hit, "The Cheater".
- 10. The 14-year-old boy who founded the City of St. Louis in 1764.

Bob Cassilly (who would go on to found the "City Museum") 8. Tennessee Williams (who stipulated in his will that he wanted to be buried at seal) 9. Bob Kuban ("and the In-Men"!) 10. 

You could be the next winner!! It is very simple, join the 150 Club! We draw a winner every month from September through April! September is just around the corner! Hurry, hurry!!


