



# **Development of the Unborn Baby— First Month**

Your spiritually adopted baby has been quite active during this first month of growing. Already your baby is 10,000 times bigger than at conception. Your baby has developed the foundations of her brain, spinal cord and nervous system by the 20<sup>th</sup> day. Her heart began to beat 18-21 days after conception. Her heart is pumping blood through her own circulatory system and her blood type can be different from her mother's. Your baby is just ½ of an inch long.
