In our Catholic piety, the month of October is given over to the Most Holy Rosary of Our Lady. Its origins are found in the famous Battle of Lepanto (which saved Christian Europe in 1571), whose success was credited to the praying of the rosary by the Pope who mobilized the Christian forces, the Dominican St. Pius V. I recommend that you pray the rosary every day during this holy month, especially in light of...

QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC

In every era of the 2,000-year history of the Catholic Church we have seen the presence of the miraculous. 
