LIGHTS! CAMERA! ACTION!

At the start of the Wuhan Flu "pandemic" (when all the parishes shut down), we jerry-rigged a camera on a table in the front of church so that we could "live-stream" our Masses to the faithful who were prohibited from attending in person. The system works, but it's not great, but so many watched (and continue to do so) that we are looking into mounting a permanent camera so that the practice may continue, for the sake of the home-bound, after we're declared "all safe" again. Right now, the system is operational, but not really of tip-top quality of either picture or sound. Our crack maintenance and I.T. crew will do as much of the work as they can. So, I'm looking for donors. I will then subsequently rise and call you blessed and the angels of heaven will rejoice!

THE MASS AT PIPER'S CHAPEL ON THE FEAST OF THE HOLY CROSS

That, of course, would be a week from Labor Day on Sept. 14. This is the plan: meet at SAM at 5:00PM that day, and carpool over to their place in O'Fallon/Cottleville for Mass at 6:00.
