From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT MARCH IS THE MONTH OF ST. JOSEPH (IN THE YEAR OF ST. JOSEPH)! PASSIONTIDE

Starting with the Fifth Sunday of Lent (today), the holy season of penance, self-denial, and renewal takes on a new character as we focus more intently and intensely on the Sufferings of Christ. This comprises the last two weeks of Lent, so much so, in fact, that it has its own distinct name: PASSIONTIDE. To express the singularly solemn tone of the season, it has long been the custom of the Church to cover the statues and holy pictures in church. This is done to create an ambiance of sadness, since the purpose of having those beautiful works of art is to communicate to the faithful the transcendent joys of heaven. And so, beginning today, our parish church will be draped in purple, anticipating the recollection and re-living of the sorrowful mysteries of our faith.

TREE-MENDOUS

Our parish grounds are beautifully kept and maintained every year by a team of green-thumbed horticulturalists who do a magnificent job of transforming our humble North County parish into a second Eden. Part of the landscaping is our forest of trees. I never really realized how many trees we had until the other day when we had a tree service up here estimating for work that needs to be done to them. It's a bunch (or should I say a *forest*?). Anyway, the bad news is that they need a lot of work (which will set us back about 7 grand), the good news is that our trees will be beautiful and healthy for several years to come. 
