CATECHISM CLASS

As I explained last week, everybody is welcome to attend, it's a great study group where all your questions can be answered (or, at least, discussed). It begins this Tuesday, Sept. 7, and will take place after the 7:00PM Devotions in the Parish Meeting Room (connected to church through the choir area, or accessible from the outside passageway adjacent to the parish offices). It will take place every first and third Tuesday and will be live streamed.

\$1,200

Speaking of live-streaming, that \$1,200 is how much we have to pay to the media service that handles all our live-streaming. It enables us to live-stream the 5:00PM Saturday and 9:30AM Sunday Masses, special events like weddings, funerals, baptisms and anything else that goes on in church (not to mention the above-mentioned Catechism Class. Many of our homebound and COVID-fearful use and depend on this service. The contract is up for renewal, and, of course, we will renew it, but it will cost us \$1,200 and so I was wondering whether some generous and noble soul will step up and shoulder the cost of it. Please let me know...

When we hate sin above all evils and are willing to endure suffering rather than sin again 7. When we are sorry for every mortal sin we have committed 8. Two: perfect and imperfect contrition 9. When our sorrow for sin is because we have offended God, whom we should love above all things

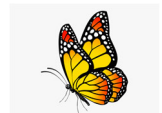
