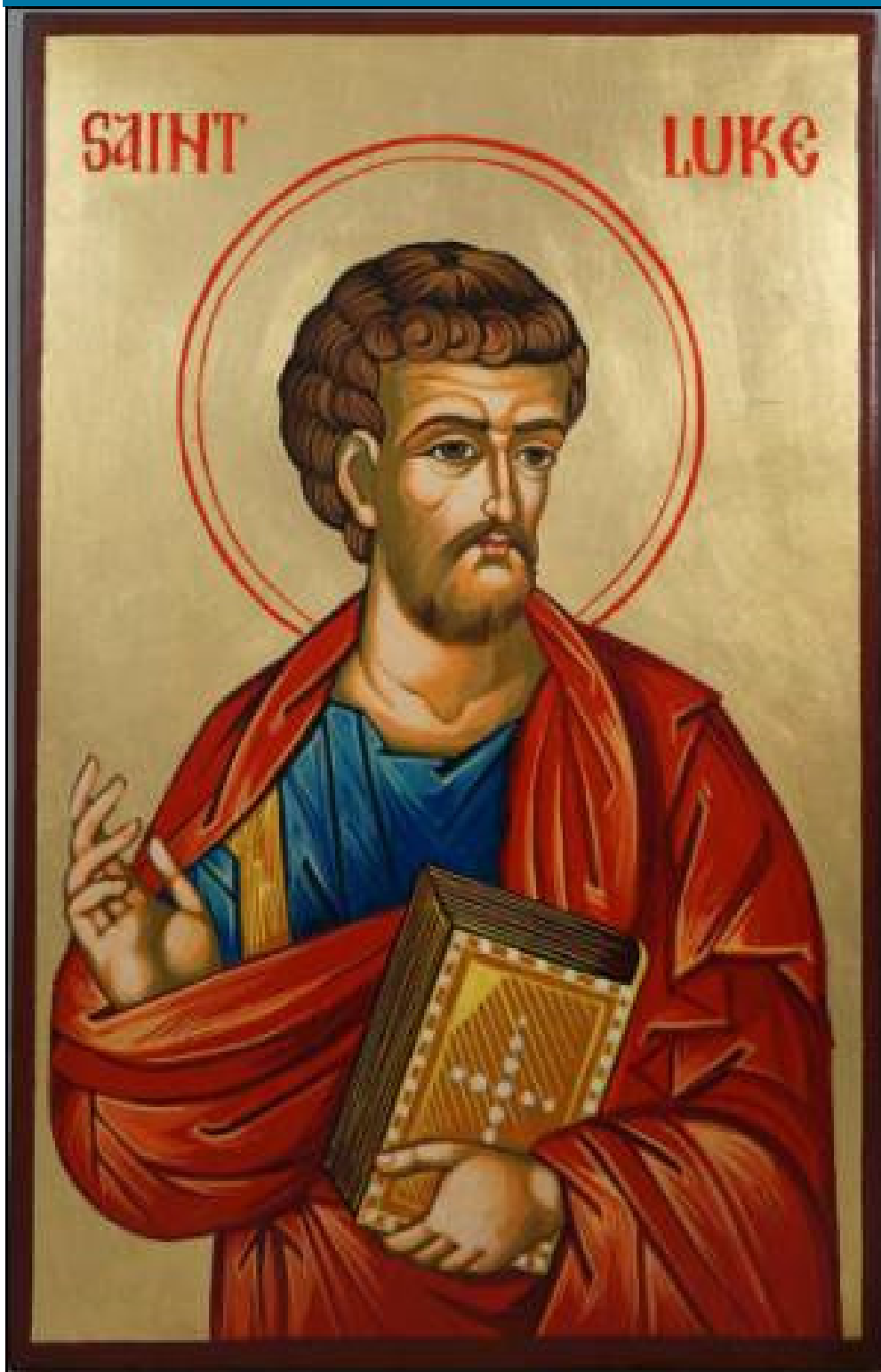

REMEMBER THAT OCTOBER IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY CONTINUES...

...and have you been praying it daily? We see in the beautiful icon of Our Mother of Perpetual Help the depiction of the legend of how the Boy Jesus, confronted by angels holding the instruments of His upcoming Passion, and understanding exactly what they meant, went for solace and comfort to the only one on earth who was capable of providing those things, namely, His sinless Mother. Now, from Her place in heaven, She stands athwart this sinful and sorrowful world and offers the same comfort and solace to us, who are, after all, Her children, too. The rosary has gotten this world through a great many predicaments, and I know it's been extremely effective in getting me through the various crises of my life. And I know I'm not the only one.

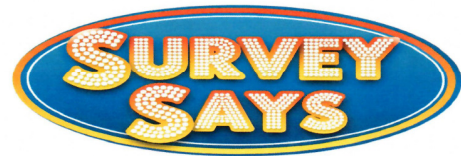
