From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT OCTOBER IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY ROSARY

THE MONTH OF THE ROSARY CONTINUES...

...so continue to pray your rosary! A short while ago, I wrote in this space about some moron representative of the mainstream media who wrote an article about something he discovered on the internet. Apparently, Catholic “gun nuts” were connecting their rosaries with their firearms, thus making their rosaries instruments of gunnuttery. He, of course, thought this was just dreadful and deplored the weaponization of the rosary. In so doing, he reminded me of Caiaphas, who declared that it is “better that One Man (Jesus) should die”, than that the Romans should slaughter many Jews in putting down a rebellion. 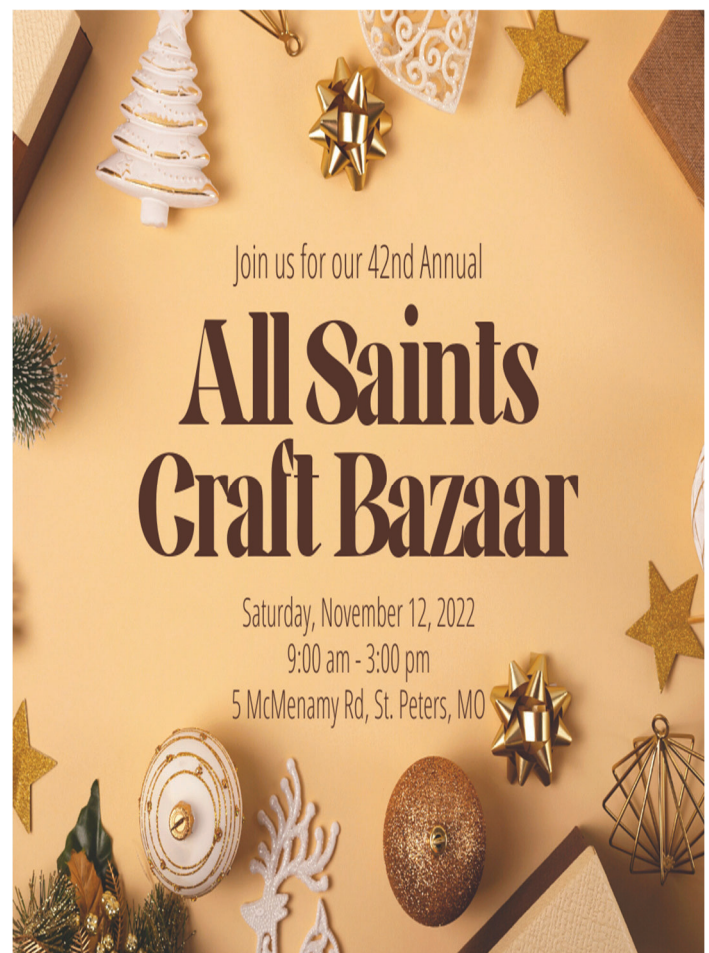
