From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!

ALL THINGS NEW

The program for the re-structuring of the Archdiocese of St. Louis is being called "All Things New" and is a once-in-a-lifetime thing. But the real time for renewal, which occurs annually, is fast upon us. I speak, of course, of the holy season of Lent. It starts March 2. Renewal is consistent with life itself. Your body, even as you sit there reading this, is renewing itself. It has to. The minute it stops is the minute you die. As goes the life of your body, so too the life of your soul. There will be enormous opportunities to renew your spiritual growth, with traditional devotions that are both year-round (like daily Mass and Eucharistic Adoration) and peculiar to the season (like Stations of the Cross, our Speaker Series, and your own personal acts of mortification and self-denial), and, most of all, special times to go to Confession; every legitimate attempt at spiritual renewal includes that.

MARDI GRAS/CHILI GRAS

Before you embrace the discipline of Lent, you need to brace yourself for its rigors in advance. I recommend the Men's Club Great Chili Cook-Off!
