## *From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:*

**REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!**

### **“ALL THINGS NEW”**

Archbishop Rozanski has announced the commencement of a program of radical change here in the Archdiocese of St. Louis. Basically, it is going to call for sweeping change in the structure of our parishes, schools, and other institutions. It is being called “All Things New”, and it is being implemented in response to the perceived demographics of fewer Catholics and fewer priests in our archdiocese. The purpose of the restructuring is to consolidate and, thereby, make vibrant, the parishes that remain. They’re giving it a couple of years to form and develop. How will that affect us here at St. Angela? In all honesty and candor, I don’t know. It is, however, possible that our parish will remain intact at least until my retirement (which is scheduled for seven years hence). There will be much discussion, with everyone having a chance to give input. I will keep you abreast of it as best I can...

### **WORLD DAY OF THE SICK**

The International World Day of the Sick coincides with the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes (and the healing waters imparted through her intercession). Consequently, I am offering the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick on that day, after Mass, for those who qualify. In order to qualify, one must be Catholic, in a state of grace, and suffer from lethal or a chronically painful affliction (old age is itself considered a qualification), or facing serious medical treatment (like chemotherapy or surgery). Just come to Mass that day, and I’ll explain everything before Mass starts.

### **MARDI GRAS**

What better way is there to prepare for the rigorous season of Lent than by a chili cook-off on Mardi Gras Eve? That’s what our Men’s Club figures, and so they’re sponsoring one (their first ever) on that day, March 1. The details will be shortly forthcoming, but if you’ve got a recipe for first-class spicy cuisine, or if you’re just hungry for spicy meat potage and want to brace yourself for coming meatless days, plan on taking part. Stay tuned...

### **IN HONOR OF ST. CASIMIR**

Of all our ethnic saints’ food nights, the Polish Dinner has always been one of the most popular, and so, we’d like to give it a spin again this year. His actual feast day is March 4, which, this year, is the first Friday of Lent. Well, you gotta have kielbasa on St. Casimir’s day, so we moved it to the next day, Saturday, March 5. The plan is to take reservations (as in the past) and serve it after Mass either in the lunchroom or gym (depending on the size of the crowd). If we don’t get enough orders, we won’t have it, and we’ll let you know in plenty of time.


