From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT MARCH IS THE MONTH OF ST. JOSEPH!

DISCIPLE-MAKER-INDEX

As you know, the Archdiocese is planning big changes in the next few years and they want our input. They have set up this “Disciple-Maker Index” (available on the internet at: allthingsnew.archstl.org/Ways-to-engage/Disciple-Maker-index) and have invited us to respond to this survey. I recommend that you do so.

CATECHISM CLASS MOVED

Because of Mardi Gras (and there being a fifth Tuesday this month), my Catechism Class will not convene this Tuesday, March 15, but will, instead, convene the following Tuesday, March 22 (same time & place), and will be live-streamed. After that, it will take place again at its usual day & time, i.e., the first and third Tuesdays of the month, in the Parish Meeting Room, after the 7:00PM Perpetual Help Devotions.

ST. JOSEPH CATHOLIC RADIO SPEAKER SERIES...

...continues this Friday, March 18 (after the Stations of the Cross at 7:00PM). The featured guest speaker: Mike Burke, speaking on the “Waiting to Die Running to Live”.

AND SPEAKING OF ST. JOSEPH...

...this coming Saturday, March 19, is his major feast day (his minor feast is May 1). To honor him we will, of course, have Mass in the morning at 8:00, but will also provide the world-class “St. Joseph Bread” to distribute, not only on his feast day, but also the whole weekend. This ancient custom pays homage to St. Joseph’s unique status as the “bread-winner” for the holy family. With that in mind, we will accept donations for the Vincent de Paul Society concurrent with the distribution of this wonderful bread.

QUIZ-A-CATHOLIC

Lent is a time for restoring and returning to the basics of our faith. With that in mind, this quiz will return to the topics contained in that venerable profession of authentic Catholic belief, the Baltimore Catechism. See whether you can name:

LENTEN SPEAKER SERIES, FRIDAY, MARCH 18TH

Please join us Friday, March 18th, after Stations of the Cross to hear Mike Burke's story of fighting adversity. Mike was diagnosed with Cystic Fibrosis (CF), when he was fourteen months old and for most of his young life, he lived with the thought that he had only 2 more years to live. This prognosis led Mike to shelter his emotions and bury himself in his work. When he was 30 and asked to provide a lecture about CF, his research revealed that he was, now, 2 years beyond his predicted death age. That revelation changed his outlook on life. He has since then become a marathon runner and was married.

In 2014 Mike 's book, **Waiting to Die, Running to Live**, was published. The book provides a fascinating account of the struggles and triumphs that he faced and the wisdom and insight that he gained over the years.
