

REMEMBER THAT APRIL IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY SPIRIT AND THE HOLY EUCHARIST!

HOLY WEEK

This week we enter the most solemn and sacred season of the year, HOLY WEEK. It's the climax of our annual Lenten retreat and is supposed to lead us up to that mountain where we find refreshment, renewal and renovation, all freed from our sins. I am extremely grateful to our parish liturgists who always magnificently set the tone for the celebration of the events of this hallowed week by decorating the church so fittingly to match what each celebration entails. It begins today with the reading of the Passion and so we see Christ depicted in His torments with the statue of the Scourged Christ. From there, we will see Him in the tomb and then, with the tomb empty, Him risen from the dead.

There will be more special times for Confession (Monday, after the 8:00AM Mass/Tuesday at 1:00PM/Wednesday After 8:00AM Mass AND at 6:00PM). Then we have the great events of the Paschal Triduum, which change our usual schedule of Masses and services. MAUNDY THURSDAY: Morning Prayer at 8:00AM, Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:30PM, followed by the adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until midnight. GOOD FRIDAY: Morning prayer at 8:00AM, Stations of the Cross at 12:00noon, and the Good Friday service at 7:30PM. HOLY SATURDAY: Morning prayer at 8:00AM, Paschal Vigil at 7:30PM. (The schedule for Easter Sunday is the usual parish Sunday schedule.) PLEASE NOTE THAT THE TIMES LISTED HERE ARE THE REAL TIMES FOR EACH EVENT.

PALM SUNDAY, THE PASSION OF THE CHRIST

Once again, our parish will have a special screening of Mel Gibson's masterpiece, *The Passion of the Christ*, today (Palm Sunday) at 2:00PM in the parish lunchroom. All, of course, are welcome. Painful though it may be to watch this film, so accurately and unsparingly does it portray for us all to see what our sins have done to Our Loving Lord, this is a beautiful, if sorrowful, way to set the tone for the remainder of the week.

ADORATION IN GETHSEMANE

Every year, the Church asks each of us, asks Jesus asked His most faithful apostles, to come and spend an hour in prayer with Him before He is made to suffer. She does this by having each parish set up its own Gethsemane, replete with Christ Himself being present in the left-over hosts from the Maundy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper. Our liturgists always set the scene so strikingly that it doesn't take much to imagine that you may actually be experiencing the real thing. People, some from all over North County (and even from Alton!), to come and pray. So, respond to the Lord's call, and come watch for an hour and "pray that you may not undergo the test!"

The movie is very graphic in its presentation of Jesus' sufferings, his sufferings for our offenses.
