From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

REMEMBER THAT JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS!

TRINITY SUNDAY

As I mentioned here last Sunday, the Church asks us to contemplate, and in contemplating to celebrate, the two greatest mysteries of our faith on the first two Sundays after Pentecost. This week, it's the Holy Trinity. And so we celebrate Trinity Sunday. Next week, the mystery celebrated and contemplated is the Real Presence of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, and it's the Feast of...

...CORPUS CHRISTI

In addition to the usual Sunday Masses, it is customary on Corpus Christi to have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament, pausing at different stopping points for prayers, Scriptures, and a Benediction. We would have one here ourselves, but since our whole community traditionally takes part in Old Town Florissant's ancient and historic Corpus Christi Procession, we will not have our own, and instead we encourage all to come to Sacred Heart at 7:00PM next Sunday. It will take place in the cool of the evening, but with plenty of daylight because it's right at the Summer Solstice. After the opening prayers and first Benediction, we will hit the streets of Old Town and walk the half-mile (downhill all the way!) to the ancient and historic (and newly air-conditioned!) St. Ferdinand Shrine for the final Benediction. Refreshments of all sorts will be provided at the Shrine, along with transportation back to Sacred Heart.

Traditionally, pride of place in the Corpus Christi Procession is given to all who have made their First Holy Communion in the given year. And so we issue a very special invitation to any and all of our parishioners who comprise this year's First Communion Class to come to Sacred Heart wearing your First Communion outfits, and take your special place in church and at the head of the parade.

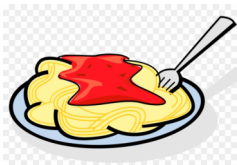
