REMEMBER THAT JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS!

CORPUS CHRISTI

One of the worst disasters in the failure of many of our Catholic systems is the deplorable ignorance and lack of faith that one finds among those who self-identify as Catholic with regard to the Eucharist. First, there is the huge number who do not believe that it is Jesus' real Body and Blood. (This despite Jesus' insistence upon that teaching in the 6th chapter of St. John's Gospel.) Second, there are those who completely misunderstand or reject the Church's 2,000-year-old teaching that only those who are worthy (i.e., in a state of grace) are able to partake of Holy Communion. (This despite St. Paul's clear warning that those who eat and drink unworthily do so to their own *damnation!*) Third, and worst of all, are the many who don't think that the Eucharist is important enough to bother to get up on a Sunday and go receive it. (This despite the 3th Commandment's clear mandate to keep the Lord's Day holy.) These tragic realities manifest a near-complete *collapse* of the Catholic faith.

Against all that, the Church gives us today's wonderful feast on which she asks us to reiterate and solidify our believe in the Lord's Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament and celebrate this sublime mystery as one of our biggest feasts. I am always edified by the many Catholics who are *daily* communicants. When I was in college, I worked downtown one summer and spent my lunch hour at one of the many noon Masses offered in the downtown churches for the many businessmen and women who were doing the same thing. Edifying! And, of course, there are the many who get up at the crack of dawn for Mass in their parish churches, too. In addition, I am also heartened by the many who come at all hours of the day and night to worship in Eucharistic Adoration, here (on Tuesdays) and at those parish that have it 24/7. Which leads me once again to exhort, encourage, and invite you to come to the historic and beautiful Corpus Christi Procession through Old Town Florissant. It starts at Sacred Heart at 7:00PM and concludes at the newly-air-cooled St. Ferdinand Shrine. The path of the march is half a mile and is downhill all the way, lasting an hour or so (with refreshments served at the end, and shuttle service back to Sacred Heart). Come and take part! (And consider being a daily communicant/weekly adorer yourself!)

CALLING OUR FIRST COMMUNICANTS!

Again, I renew the invitation to all our First Communicants to march in their special place in the Corpus Christi Procession, in their First Communion attire. Pride of place is given to them in the front, and so they should sit up front with their families in Sacred Heart and then join in behind the servers.
