

HOLY INFANT OF PRAGUE

Many of our devout and eagle-eyed parishioners have noticed the absence of our statue of the Holy Infant of Prague. More to the point, they have all come up to me and asked me, privately, what happened to Him? Well, I should have said something here before now, but it kept slipping my mind. The Infant who had been there is getting a much-needed bath and change of apparel. In His place, I put, temporarily, a likeness of the Holy Infant that I acquired from the Carmelites who staff the gift shop at the church of Our Lady of Victory in Prague, the site of the original statue of the Infant of Prague. (He's called the "Infant" because He is one, and "of Prague" because that's where His statue is.) He will return soon, looking, as my grandmother used to say, "like downtown"! Devotion to the Holy Infant is ancient and beautiful, and you'll find Him in practically every Catholic parish church all throughout the world because it is widely believed that the more Jesus is honored as Infant of Prague, the less your parish will be in debt! (We are not in debt...'nuff said!)
