

## From The Desk of Msgr. Matthew Mitas:

#### REMEMBER AUGUST IS THE MONTH OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT!

#### I BET YOU HAVEN'T NOTICED

Some people have come up to me mentioning how much cooler their place in church is and how they can really feel the cool air cascading over them. That's a phenomenon recently applied to our whole church, namely, the replacement of the previous plain and purely utilitarian vents with new, ecclesiastically-proper and harmonious-with-our-parish-church vents. I think they're beautiful and they're part of our 60<sup>th</sup> diamond jubilee celebration. They were paid for by the Men's Club, for which we thank them greatly!
