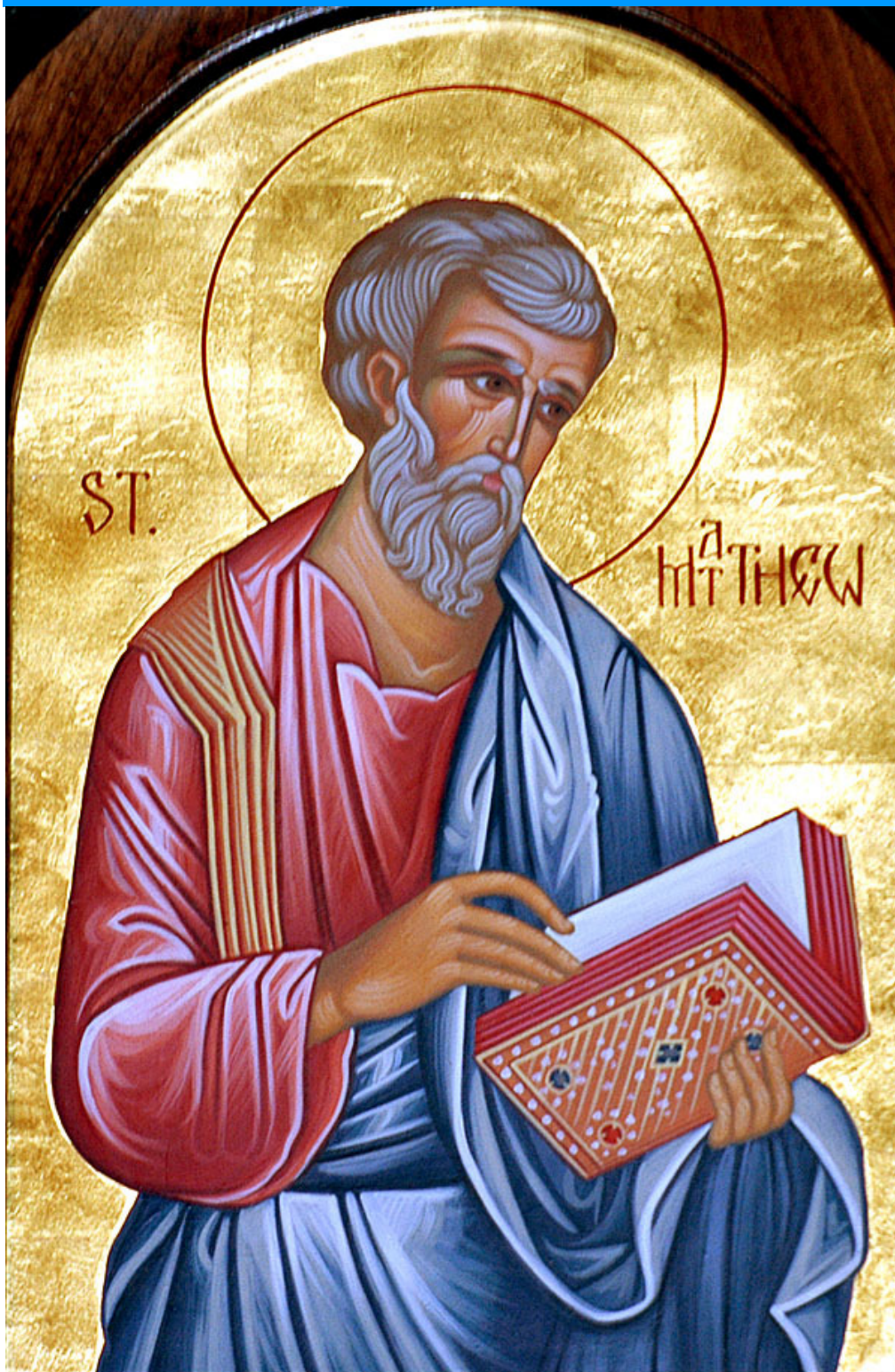

The guarantee from Christ that the Church will last until the end of time 8. That she is one, holy, catholic, and apostolic 9. All its members agree in one faith, one Communion & worship, and under one Head 10. In the pope, whose infallible authority to teach the faithful will last until the end of time
