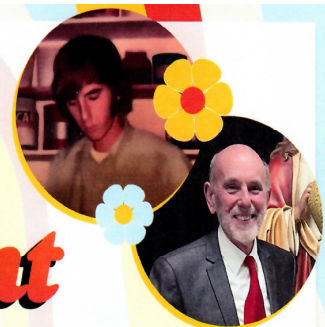

LOOKING AHEAD

Ash Wednesday and the start of Lent is less than a month away, so we need to start getting ready for that. In what has now become a parish tradition, one of the non-spiritual ways in which we will prepare the body for the rigors of Lenten discipline is with the 2nd annual St. Angela Merici Men's Club chili cook-off! Just like last year, we are inviting the chili chefs of Shoveltown to strut their stuff and exhibit their wares to the chili-loving community of North County. The attendees can then, for a fee, sample as many different types of chili as their purse-strings (and stomach-wall linings) will accommodate. It will take place on Sunday afternoon, Feb. 19.

The St. Joseph Catholic Radio will also sponsor its annual Lenten Speaker Series here at our parish, to coincide with our weekly walking of the Stations of the Cross on the Fridays of Lent.

LAST WORD ON THE ITALY TRIP (FOR A WHILE)

We had our big organizational meeting last Tuesday and it was great. It looks like we're going to have a really good cluster of pilgrims, in numbers, enthusiasm, and fellowship. Now is the time to start making concrete preparations for trip. PRESENTATION AND ST. BLAISE

There are two big feasts this week, back-to-back: Thursday is the Presentation of the Lord (Candlemas) and Friday is the feast of St. Blaise. Each has its own unique liturgical feature. On Thursday, we'll meet with lit candles in the vestibule for the start of Mass, and on Friday, we'll have the traditional blessing of throats. Plan on being there for both!

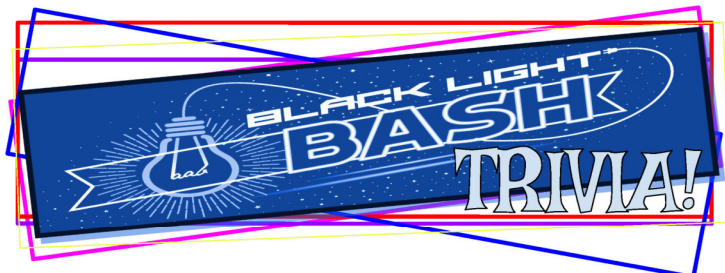

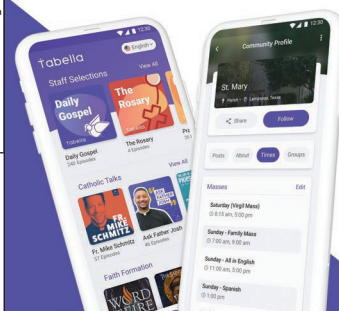
