REMEMBER THAT FEBRUARY IS THE MONTH OF THE HOLY FAMILY!

THE MONTH OF FEVERS

That's what the Romans called February, and they were right. To vitiate the sickness and affliction caused by ill health, the Church, over the centuries, has come up with some traditional and well-established ways of dealing with them. First, we have the special blessing of throats on the feast of St. Blaise (last Friday). St. Blaise was on the roster of fourteen "useful saints" that the practical-minded Germans assembled to deal with the chronic problems that continually plague humanity. Colds and throat maladies are at the top of that list, and that makes the fourth-century Armenian bishop and martyr a very valuable commodity. In addition to that, we have the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. You all know the story of St. Bernadette and the apparitions to her by the Blessed Mother, the result of which was a flow of miraculously healing waters. Those waters still surge to this day (and still affect miraculous healings). Because of the healing events of Lourdes, the Church has specified the feast day (Our Lady of Lourdes, Feb. 11) as the...

...WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

It seems to be a natural that this annual festival of the healing gifts that flow from the prayers of the Blessed Mother should be a day of special prayer for the sick. And so, even though it falls this year on a Saturday, we will have a special Mass at 8:00AM on Saturday morning, February 11, at which I will offer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick to those who qualify. Understand: this is *not* a "blessing"; this is a *sacrament*. Who qualifies? To be a proper recipient of this sacrament, one must be:

A) Catholic, and B) suffer an affliction that is either chronic, painful, debilitating, life-threatening, embarrassing, or any combination thereof. If you're only suffering a mild cold, you wouldn't qualify. Merely being advanced in age doesn't qualify you, either. But if you suffer greatly or chronically because of your cold, or from the painful effects of a dilapidating older body (like chronic arthritis), then you would qualify. Who makes the determination as to whether or not you qualify? Well, you do. Keep in mind: the greater the faith with which one receives this gift, the greater the healing result (just look at all the accounts of Christ's healings in the Gospels). So come to Mass next Saturday. Once you're in place, I'll explain how it all works and, after the homily, the sacrament will be imparted.



Any day of the week, we can use more volunteers! This is a big challenge for us! We are open 4 hours Monday-Friday and 2 hours on Saturday.

<u>Warehouse workers</u>- We definitely have a shortage of men or women who can lift up to 40 lbs., entails stocking and restocking food for orders we fill each day, along with sorting food donations.
