REMINDERS:

St Vincent de Paul Food Drive for the month of April will be moved to the weekend of 12th & 13th.

Jesus took Peter, John, and James and went up the mountain to pray.
While he was praying his face changed in appearance and his clothing became dazzling white.
- Luke 9: 28-30

On the second Sunday of Lent, we move from Jesus' retreat to the desert and temptation by the devil to the mountain top to experience glory shown in Jesus' Transfiguration. In Luke's account, we are told that Jesus took Peter, John and James up the mountain to pray and in that moment, they experienced the glory of God. The mountain in the Bible always represents a place close to God and an intimate encounter with Him, a place of prayer where one stands in the presence of the Lord. Throughout history, many holy men and women have experienced "mountaintop" experiences.

During this Lenten season, as we were invited last week to a 40-day journey in the desert; we are also invited the mountain top to pray, to the mountain top to experience an intimate encounter with the Lord. God invites us to know Him deeper, to know ourselves as being love by Him and then to rest in His peace.

In His Transfiguration, we also see an anticipation of the glory of Jesus' Resurrection. In each of the reports of the Transfiguration, the disciples keep secret what they have seen. Not until they also witness His Passion and death will the disciples understand Jesus' Transfiguration. We hear this story of Jesus' Transfiguration early in Lent, but we have the benefit of hindsight. In our hearing of it, we anticipate Jesus' Resurrection even as we prepare to remember Jesus' Passion and death.

May God lead you to the mountaintop this Lent, Deacon George
